"RESOLVED" that the Board of Education of the Stockbridge Valley Central School District, pursuant to Section 2509 of the Education Law and in compliance with Part 30.3 of the Rules of the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Sarah Dunlay to the position of Grades 1-6 Teacher in the tenure area of Grades 1-6 Childhood Education for a probationary period of four years, to commence on September 1, 2022, and to expire on September 1, 2026 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012³ of the education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Mrs. Dunlay will hold a valid New York State Certificate permitting her to serve in the field of Childhood Education Grades 1-6, AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during her first year of this appointment be paid at Step 1, \$54,093. There were 7 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.

A motion was made by J. Renner, seconded by H. Bingel, be it:

"RESOLVED" that the Board of Education of the Stockbridge Valley Central School District, pursuant to Section 2509 of the Education Law and in compliance with Part 30.3 of the Rules of the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Mary Beth Maguire to the position of 7-12 Art Teacher in the tenure area of 7-12 Art for a probationary period of three years, to commence on September 1, 2022, and to expire on September 1, 2025 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012³ of the education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or

overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least two (2) of the three (3) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. Mrs. Maguire will hold a valid New York State Certificate permitting her to serve in the field of 7-12 Art, AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during her first year of this appointment be paid at Off Step \$60,000. There were 7 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.

Bingel, the Board appointed Marylynn Price as a full-time Teacher Assistant for a probationary period of three years, to commence on September 1, 2022, and to expire on September 1, 2025 (unless extended in accordance with the law).
