

School Climate



Students who report that LBUSD provides a positive learning **environment** = 85%

Students who report learning is **relevant** to post-high school interests = 71%

Students who report they regularly participate in **challenging** learning activities = 76%

Students who report that staff provide **meaningful** school work = 81%

Chronically Absent = 16.5%

Average Daily
Attendance = 94%

Students who report social and emotional counseling services are available = 85%

Students who report they do NOT have time in the day to discuss concerns with staff = 23%

Suspension Rate = 2.4%

Expulsion Rate = 0.08%
