### **Principal's Report**

- SC Ready testing update-testing complete, scores embargoed, but we will discuss in a later meeting.
- iReady testing next week
- End of year ceremonies-June 4
- Teacher appreciation was a huge success-thanks to Kay for securing so many gift cards and other gifts from community businesses.
- Field day was a success-thanks to SIC for recommending inflatables

### **Old Business**

- Of the 90 students we currently have enrolled in 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade, 45 of them have been here since kindergarten.

### **New Business**

- School renewal plan (Academic)
  - Similar to last year with a 10% increase over a five year period.
  - District goal-60% of 2<sup>nd</sup> graders to be on grade level in reading
  - District goal-80% of 3-5 approaches, met, or exceeds
    - PRES is lower than 80% but we are not including approaches.
  - Strategies for meeting academic goals
    - iReady goal setting-discussed our student goal setting conferences.
    - Teacher assessments within the classroom.
    - MTSS levels of support.
    - Continue to fund academic tutors through Title I budget.

*Proud to be a Title 1 School*

- Fund numeracy coach through Title I budget.
  - Question about teacher collaboration regarding students as they move from one grade level to the next.
- School Renewal Plan (School Climate)
  - Currently 11.8% chronic absenteeism percentage. 5 year goal is to decrease to 6.8% or less.
  - Kay asked about tardies-this information does not include tardies, but tardies are a significant concern.
  - Strategies for meeting School Climate goals
    - Parent Education
  - Discussion about what we are currently doing for attendance.
- School Renewal Plan (Teacher/Administrator Quality)
  - Professional development credits including, but not limited to literacy instruction, gifted instructions, project based learning, trauma informed teaching, and teaching students of poverty.
- Budget increases (teacher salary, additional staff, step increase from 27 to 28, 3% cost of living, healthcare cost increase).
- Title I Budget-slight increase in funds.
  - Conversations with teachers-revamp independent reading program
    - Classroom libraries
