Resource Store & Library Impact


- All 33 Campuses, Administration & Transportation have utilized the program
- 1,330 Individual Educators Served
- 3,337 Total Orders Fulfilled
- More than 171,447 items have been distributed

The program has saved NISD educators an estimated **\$507,100.47** in the 2023-24 school year from August to May.

In the 2023-24 school year, NEF partnered with NISD to take the program to a digital inventory system!


Teachers now make requests online using <u>Paperform</u> and check out via Follett Destiny so all inventory and data is easily managed for the foundation and its donors.

- Other popular items include: privacy shields, composition notebooks, sanitizing wipes, tissues, dry erase sleeves, binders




Other Initiatives

CTE Internships

NEF partners with the district's Career and Technical Education department to provide internship opportunities for the Family and Community Services program. Students take an active role in managing the Store and Library throughout the year, along with supporting other NEF programs and events to gain real-world experience with a nonprofit organization.



District Partnerships

The Store and Library program has also made it possible for NEF to partner with district continuum of transition services and occupational prep classrooms. For example, students in the <u>Northwest ISD RISE</u> <u>Program</u> can choose NEF as one of their job sites each week to practice skills that will help them successfully transition to adult life and/or gain employment.



Volunteers

This program has opened a new door for volunteers wanting to get involved with the foundation! We actively engage corporate partners like Charles Schwab during their national volunteer week, in addition to campus PTA groups, NISD students and community members. Volunteers help sticker, barcode and restock inventory in the store and library.



Community Drives

Unlike a traditional fundraiser, the store and library provides an opportunity for NEF to engage student and neighborhood groups that want to give back in their own unique way. For example, a Girl Scout group who puts together snack sets as a community service project or the student-led nonprofit, Smart Initiatives, who hosted a drive and donated more than 500 books!


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
