A. CALL TO ORDER

D. OPEN FORUM TO RECEIVE INPUT RELATED TO RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ELEMENTARY ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES AND THEIR IMPLEMENTATION

The following community members addressed the Board regarding the 2018 Elementary Boundary Adjustment recommendations:

- Amy Hurta – 2237 Carlisle Ct. – Spoke against changing a portion of the neighborhood from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek citing safety concerns.
- Kathy Anders – 4211 Colchester St. - Spoke against changing a portion of the neighborhood from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek citing safety concerns.
- Lara Burhenn – 2320 Carisbrooke Loop – Spoke against the process used to obtain public involvement in the decision making process and disagreed with the demographer's recommendation.
- Susan Fontaine – 5244 Branding Iron Ct. – Spoke against the process used to involve parents in the decision making process ahead of time.
- Shawn Palermo – 2072 Ravenstone Loop – Spoke against moving students from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek citing safety concerns.
- Genevieve Le – 2307 Carisbrooke Loop – spoke against the Victoria split due to the low number of students involved.
- Fei Yang – 4219 Colchester Ct. – Spoke against dividing Castlegate I and Castlegate II.

- Kelli Campbell – 18064 Saddle Creek Dr. – Spoke against the process used and requested allowing for additional public comment if there are changes made. Also spoke against adding traffic to I&GN road.
- Katie Hazelwood – *Elected not to address the Board at this time.*
- Laura Nickelson – 4200 Ludlow Ln. – Spoke against moving kids from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek citing safety concerns and requested allowing all kids already enrolled to be able to grandfather.
- Corrine Waddell - 2200 Carlisle Ct. – Spoke against moving kids from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek and requested that all students already enrolled be allowed to grandfather.
- Megan Lupoli – 2367 Norham Dr. - Spoke against moving from Forest Ridge to Spring Creek and requested expanded grandfathering for those currently in attendance and their siblings.
- Kristi Wolff – 14232 I&GN Rd. – Spoke to increased traffic issues on I&GN that rezoning will cause and against moving students from Greens Prairie to River Bend. Requested expanding grandfathering to include current students and expanding opportunities for public input.
- Elaine Fivza – 503 Southwest Parkway - Requested expanding grandfathering to include siblings.
