



Job Title: Part-time Lifeguard

Department: Staff, GSSP

Supervisor: Assistant Afternoon Instructional Clinics Coordinator

Position Overview: This position involves ensuring the safety of and administering first-aid care to campers during creek walk.

Employment Classification: Temporary, part-time

Scheduled Days and Hours: This position requires availability Monday - Thursday from 2pm-5pm. Possible weekend hours available. The position runs from July 1st - August 1st.

Compensation: \$18.00

Essential Job Functions:

- Reflect the Mission of The Gow School Summer Program to campers/students, faculty and the community, and adhere to all company policies as listed in the GSSP Staff Handbook
- Exhibit The Gow School's core beliefs, embodied in our Four Pillars of kindness, respect, honesty and hard work
- Ensure the safety of campers in the creek on campus.
- Administer immediate care for injury or illnesses that occur at or during creek activities
- Demonstrate commitment to the philosophy and goals of camp and devotion to the position, with a sense of selflessness; demonstrate ownership and "buy-in" to the influence and impact on the program

Required knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Positive and enthusiastic attitude
- Patient, caring and creative
- Excellent judgment, ability to identify problems and work quickly to find solutions
- Flexible, adaptive and a team player
- Ability to work effectively with others in all levels of the organization in a professional manner
- Hard working, with an endurance to work up to 14 hours per day, or as needed

Qualifications: Must have a valid lifeguard certification that has not expired prior to August 2, 2024, must be at least the age of 17 years old, must be CPR certified, must pass all background checks.
