Option #1: One-Pager

Use construction paper, cardstock, or printer paper to create a one-page poster depicting the features of your book in words, images, and symbols. Be sure to include the following:

- **Your Name**
 - **Book Title**
 - **Author**
 - **Genre**
 - **# of pages**
 - **Main characters**
 - **Theme**
 - **Summary** (what happened in the story?)
 - **Favorite quote**
 - **Review the book**
 - **Image** (include a photo or drawing that relates to the book)
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Option #2: Character Journal Entry

Directions: Choose ONE character from your novel. Then choose THREE different scenes from the story to retell in journal entry form. Invent an approximate date for each entry. Write in first person narration from your character's perspective. Write from their "voice." How might you convey their personality through your writing? Consider their vocabulary, personality, and attitude. Be sure to include details about the plot and conflict. Convey your character's thoughts, emotions, etc. EACH of the THREE entries should be at least TWO paragraphs in length. Use the template below to craft your entries.

Option #3: Graphic Novel Page
