
FREEDOM & RESPONSIBILITY

STRIVING FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE


- Highly qualified educators

6TH GRADE GT/HONORS

Identification for Gifted/Talented Services in Middle School Programs:

•Students may receive G/T identification in the area of their strength, English, Social Studies, Math, Science, or in all four disciplines. Effective 2018-2019: Students are required to successfully meet expectations on STAAR annually to continue GT/Honors services in their specific identified content area.

Middle School STANDARD CRITERIA: English, Social Studies, Math, Science

- 80 or higher average in previously completed prerequisite core content area course AND
- Prior year STAAR content area passed with Meets Grade Level. If there is no STAAR score for that content, student must "Meets Grade Level" performance standards on the most current Reading STAAR. OR
- 7th and 8th graders enrolled in AVID elective course or have an Approved Opt-In Form.
