Frequently Asked Questions

IMPORTANT NOTE: For child safeguarding reasons, Singapore American School does not work with agencies or third parties. Registrations should be made by parents only. By registering, parent(s) understand that they are required to be present with their child in Singapore during the week the child is registered.

Can non-SAS Students join Summer Semester?

Yes, we welcome all students, local and international.

How do I register for Summer Semester ?

Registration happens in SchoolsBuddy and parents must register their child for activities. Please pay attention to the eNews or the summer semester [website](#) for registration dates, schedules and other important information. Click [here](#) to view the full registration process.

How many courses can I choose for each week?

You may only choose one course each week.

Are all courses taught in English?

All our courses are taught in English unless otherwise specified in the course description. (ex. Bilingual English and Chinese).

How many participants are there in each course?

The maximum number of participants is capped at 15.

Can we request for a campus tour?

SAS does not offer campus tours to summer semester applicants. However, if you are interested in the regular academic year, you may book a campus tour through the Admissions Office.

Do students get school credit from attending Summer Semester courses?

No. All summer semester courses are non-credit courses.

*(*With the exception of Algebra and Geometry courses – only available to current SAS students)*

Is a student visa required?

As it is a short-term course, a student visa is not required to attend the program. A valid tourist / short-term visit pass will be sufficient.

Does the tuition fee include bus services?

No, the tuition fee does not include bus services. Please note that this service is optional and needs to be booked separately.

Does SAS provide accommodation for international participants?

SAS does not offer boarding or dorm services for the Summer Semester program.

Participants will have to source out for their own hotel or accommodation during their stay. Parent(s) is/are expected to be in Singapore while their child(ren) attends Summer Semester class(es).

Are there any vaccination requirements?

To participate in Summer Semester, all students must have:

- For students above 12 years old [must meet the COVID-19 vaccination requirements](#)
- Two MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccines upon reaching 18 months of age
- Four DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis) vaccines upon reaching 18 months of age
- A fifth Tdap (tetanus toxoid, reduced diphtheria toxoid, and acellular pertussis) booster at 10 to 11 years of age

All non-SAS participants are required to complete this [medical form](#) before the start of the program. The immunization records must be attached to the medical form. Please ensure you complete, sign and return a scanned copy/a clear photograph of this form and all supporting documents to summersemester@sas.edu.sg.

When will I receive information after registration?

You will receive an email containing logistical information such as arrival/pick-up, lunch ordering, and dress codes a few days before the start of the program.

What if my child gets ill or catches COVID, will I get a refund?

There will be [no refunds](#) for missed days due to illness (including COVID).

Does SAS work with third-party travel/educational agencies?

SAS does not work with external agencies, we have a robust system and we advocate direct communication with parents/guardians of our participants. Parent(s) is/are expected to be in Singapore while their child attends Summer Semester classes.

Is there a uniform/dress code?

Students are allowed to wear non-SAS attire while still adhering to school dress codes which is summed up below;

- Shorts and skirts should be mid-thigh or longer.
- Spaghetti straps, strapless, or midriff tops are not permitted.
- Clothing or jewelry depicting drugs, alcohol, profanity, or sexual innuendo is not permitted.

Is lunch provided?

Lunch is included as a part of the Summer Semester fees.

Students may bring their own food; however, no refrigeration or microwave is available.

Please bring snacks that may be required throughout the day as there is no access to the cafeteria for general purchases.

Terms and Conditions

Where applicable late registrations may be permitted if space is available. Original program costs will not be prorated. An exception will be made for students who are new to SAS.

Switches are generally not permitted after you have registered for an activity. Switches may be considered on a case by case basis subject to available space. Switches will not be prorated.

There will be no make-up classes for missed days due to illness, weather, appointments, etc.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

No refunds are permitted with the following exceptions; families who are relocating or long term injuries.

Long term injury refunds will be determined on a case by case scenario. Please contact the Summer Semester office directly.

Insurance Coverage

The school maintains commercial insurance coverage for customary risks including comprehensive liability, property loss (school-owned property only), and fire, among others. The school does not maintain medical or accident insurance for students, parents, or guests, or for theft or loss of personal property such as laptops and mobile phones. Parents are encouraged to arrange such insurance with one of the many carriers in Singapore.
