The reading questions that appear below can be answered as students complete their reading. Doing so will increase their comprehension of the text.

These questions reflect a basic understanding of the 5 W's--who, what, where, when, and why. Additional consideration should be given to conflict, plot development, and theme. (For more options access the Graphic Organizers links on the PRHS Summer Reading webpage.)

* Who are the main characters in the story? Describe what is unique about each.

* What is the setting? Remember that setting includes time (when?) and place (where?).

* Summarize the basic plot/action in the story.

* What decisions does the main character make? Why?

* What challenges does the main character encounter? How is each challenge handled?



* How does the story end? What happens to the main character by the end?
