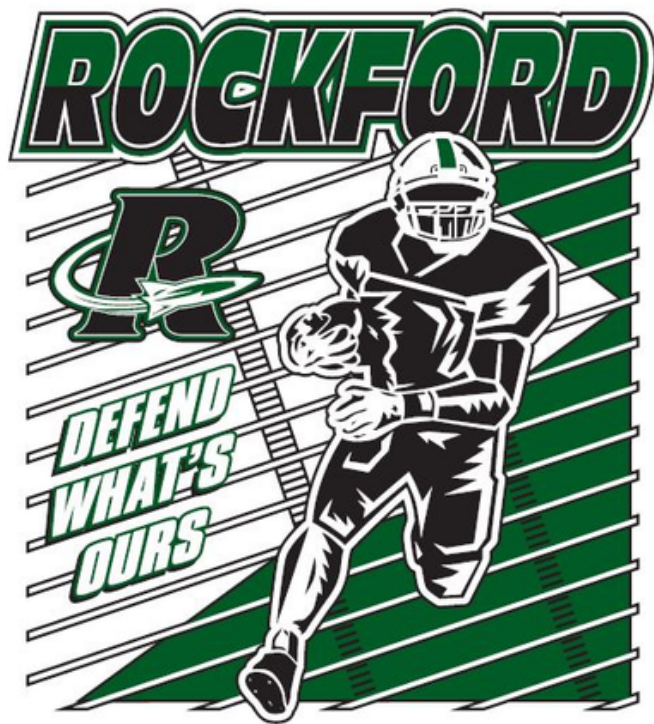

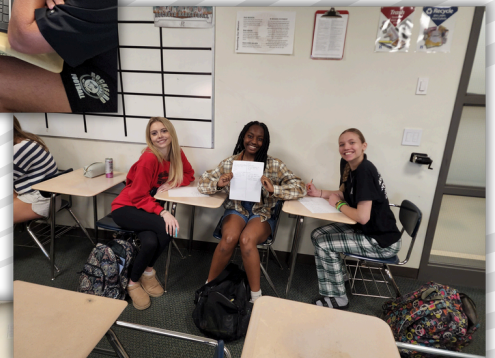


DP Spanish Letters

New to Rockford High School: The Certified Nursing Assistant Program



During the 2023 - 2024 school year, Rockford High School implemented the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Career Pathway through the International Baccalaureate program. The students take the CNA course for eighteen weeks and learn to care for residents in long term care facilities and patients in hospitals. Each student will take their CNA exam (paid for by the IB Grant) and if they are able to pass it obtain employment as a Certified Nursing Assistant. This course is taught by our District Nurse Becca Morgan, and Phy Ed/Health teacher Alayna Maher.
