### **ANDERSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

### **2024 - 2025 PRELIMINARY BUDGET PRESENTATION**


The Board of Trustees heard an update from the Assistant Superintendent of Business Services on the Governor's May Revision Budget and the Westminster School District's 2024-25 Preliminary Budget. The report provided a breakdown of the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA), multi-year projection assumptions, and enrollment data. The presentation also outlined a variety of state budget updates that include updates to universal meals, arts funding, and school facilities funding. ### **PROPOSITION 28 ARTS PLAN (ARTS AND MUSIC IN SCHOOLS)**

The Board of Trustees heard an update from the Educational Services Department regarding the Proposition 28 Arts Plan. The extensive plan covers Focus Area 1.0 of the Strategic Plan which is an emphasis on Academic Achievement & Continuous Innovation. Ed Services explained why an Arts Task force was crucial to developing a plan to implement an arts program districtwide. ### **WSD INFANT/TODDLER PROGRAM EXPANSION**

The Board of Trustees heard an update from The Educational Services Department on the plans to expand the district's Infant and Toddler Spanish Dual Language Immersion (SDLI) and Vietnamese Dual Language Immersion (VDLI) Program Expansion.
