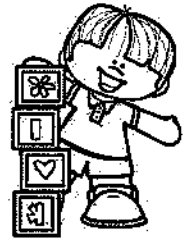

Before you shop for school supplies this summer, we are providing a suggested supply list for your Kindergartner to have to start the school year. These materials will enhance your child's classroom learning. Please do NOT label any of the items with your child's name, but place them in a zip lock bag and put your child's name on the outside of the bag.

**** Students do not share supplies, so please make sure to send in all of the supplies for your student.**

- 1- Crayola 10 pack Classic Colors Broadline Markers (Not Washable)
- 1- Crayola 12 pack Colored Pencils (Not Erasable)
- 1- Crayola 24 count crayons (Not Washable)
- 6 to 8 -Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 1-Elmer's Washable School Glue (4 oz)
- 2 -Black Expo brand large chisel tip dry erase markers
- 2-Black Expo brand fine tip dry erase markers
- 1- pair of white children's socks (can get at dollar tree)
- 2 -Black Flair felt tip pens (found in office supply section of stores)
- 1 to 2 - Erasers (standard pink)
- 1- pair of Fiskars (blunt tip) scissors
- 1- Backpack, large enough for a 9x12 folder to fit into (no toddler size)
- 1- Lunchbox (if going to be bringing lunch from home)
- 1- Box of Kleenex
- 1- Container of Disinfecting Wipes
- 2- Mr. Clean Sponges
- \$6.00 (cash) to cover the cost of headphones for the computer lab

Recommended School Supply List for Gardenhill 1st Grade Students

Before you shop for school supplies this summer, here is our recommended supply list for your 1st grader to have to start the school year. These materials will enhance your child's classroom learning. **Please place them in a bag, put your child's name on the outside of the bag, and send all items with your child on the first day of school.** We will be supplying a homework folder for your student.

Thank you in advance. - The First Grade Team

We ask that you send a **standard size pencil box (6X9X3 no larger, no handles)** with your child's name ready to go. The pencil box should include the items listed below. **Please write your child's name on the pencil box and the items in the box with a sharpie.**

- 1 – standard sized pencil box (6x9x3, no larger, no zipper pouches please)
- 1 - Elmer's glue stick
- 1 - pair of Fiskars rounded edge children's scissors
- 2 - #2 pencils sharpened
- 1 – pink rectangular eraser
- 1 - Expo brand large fat black dry erase marker
- 1 - Crayola box of 24 count crayons
- 1 – yellow (fat) Sharpie Highlighter chisel tip
- 1 – Backpack, large enough for a 9x12 folder to fit into, please write your child's name on it.

Other supplies we will need are listed below. Some of the supplies will be shared in community baskets on the tables or stored and handed out during certain activities. Please place these items in a bag with your child's name clearly on or in the bag and send on the first day of school.

- ☐ 1 - **pack of #2 pencils* (24 pack sharpened)**
- ☐ 1 - Crayola 8/10 pack of classic color broadline (fat) markers
- ☐ 1 - Crayola 12 pack colored pencils
- ☐ **12 - Elmer's glue sticks* (extras welcome)**
- ☐ **1 - Elmer's Washable School Glue (4oz)**
- ☐ **5 - Expo brand large fat dry erase markers BLACK COLOR ONLY (extras welcome)**
- ☐ 1 – spiral notebook wide rule (with 70 pages found at Walmart & Target)
- ☐ 1 – composition book wide rule (found at Walmart & Target)
- ☐ 1 - set of headphones for the computer, no ear buds please, if last year's still work-send those. Please put the headphones in a ziploc bag with their name on the headphones and on the bag.
- ☐ **1 - box of Kleenex (extras welcome)**
- ☐ **1 - box of Baby Wipes**

Prices are cheaper in July and August.

If you are able to send extras of the items in bold, thanks – these items are needed throughout the school year and will need to be replenished regularly.

Supplies to keep at home for homework and projects: We recommend pencils, sharpener, scissors, crayons, colored pencils, glue sticks, index cards (flash cards), paper (binder paper or any notebook paper is fine). Please purchase only the brands listed above. Education code section 32065 prohibits schools from purchasing and receiving products that contain toxic or carcinogenic substances.

SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Dear Incoming Second Grade Parents,

Before you shop for school supplies, please read over our recommendations and suggestions. Our hope is for all students to feel prepared and ready to learn on the first day of school.

**Every child should have a backpack they can use to carry any work, folders, books, and notes home in on a daily basis.

*box of 24 pack crayons

*1 box of #2 pencils-Ticonderoga are the best(please, no mechanical types!)

*erasers

*10-12 glue sticks

*2-3 highlighters

*scissors (we recommend the Fiskars brand)

*pencil box-we prefer the standard 6x9x3 with NO handles

*2-3 dry erase markers and an eraser

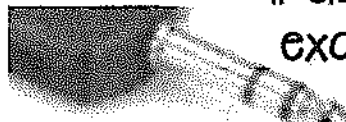
*black Sharpie

*1 box of Kleenex tissues

*1 package of baby wipes

*1 box of gallon or sandwich size Ziploc bags

***EACH CHILD NEEDS EARPHONES OR EARBUDS...please make sure the metal plug is straight to plug into the iPads, the ones that curve (L shape) will not fit with iPad case. Please NO large headphones!

3RD GRADE SUPPLY DONATIONS

Please have your child bring the following items on the 1st day of school

- * standard sized pencil box- (NO POUCHES PLEASE)
- * pack of glue sticks
- * 3 sharpened pencils
- * an eraser
- * 2 dry erase markers
- * school-safe scissors
- * a highlighter
- * Crayola crayons (24 count)- please label with your child's name

We also hope that over the summer you will start working on multiplication facts! You should try to master the 0-2's, 5's, and 10's before school starts. Of-course, you don't have to stop there! Try the 3-4 and maybe 6's, if you dare!

4TH GRADE SUPPLY DONATIONS

Please have the following items in your child's PENCIL BOX OR POUCH ready to go. **EVERYTHING MUST FIT** in ONE standard-sized box or pouch:

- * A Glue Stick
- * 2 sharpened #2 pencils
- * An eraser
- * A black dry erase marker
- * An eraser for dry erase board
- * School-safe scissors
- * A highlighter
- * Pencil sharpener with a case (holder for peelings)
- * A black fine tip marker (Ultra Fine Sharpie or Flair)
- * A regular Fine Point Sharpie

Your child will also need the following (they do not need to fit in their box or pouch):

- * A ruler that includes inches and centimeters
- * A 3-subject spiral notebook (MEAD 5-Star are the best)
- * 2 2-pocket folders (1 for homework and 1 for schoolwork)
- * Box of markers (fine tip)
- * Box of markers (broad top)
- * Colored pencils (12-24)
- * Earphones or earbuds

Classroom Supplies (please bring these in a bag for the class to use throughout the year. These DO NOT need to be labeled):

- * Elmer's glue bottles (2)
- * Glue sticks (5+)
- * box of Kleenex
- * baby wipes or Clorox wipes
- * sharpened pencils (2 boxes — 12 or 24)
- * Dry eraser markers (2+) - no RED
- * 2 Black fine top markers (Ultra Fine Sharpie or Flair)
- * 2 regular Sharpie (fine point)
