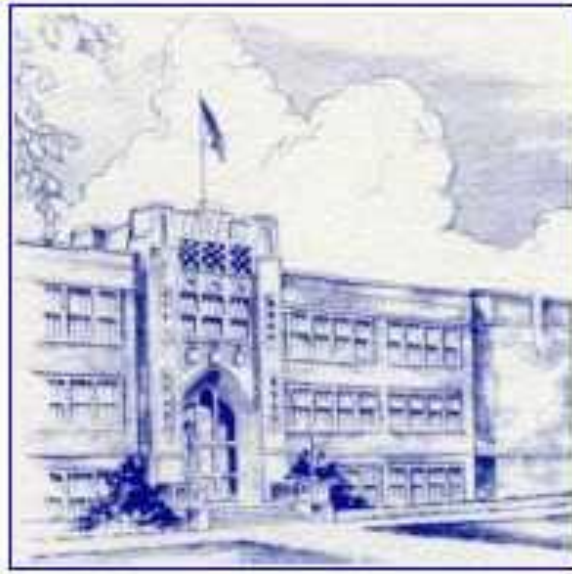

SNAPSHOT 2023 provides extensive data from which observations about the District can be drawn. They include the following:



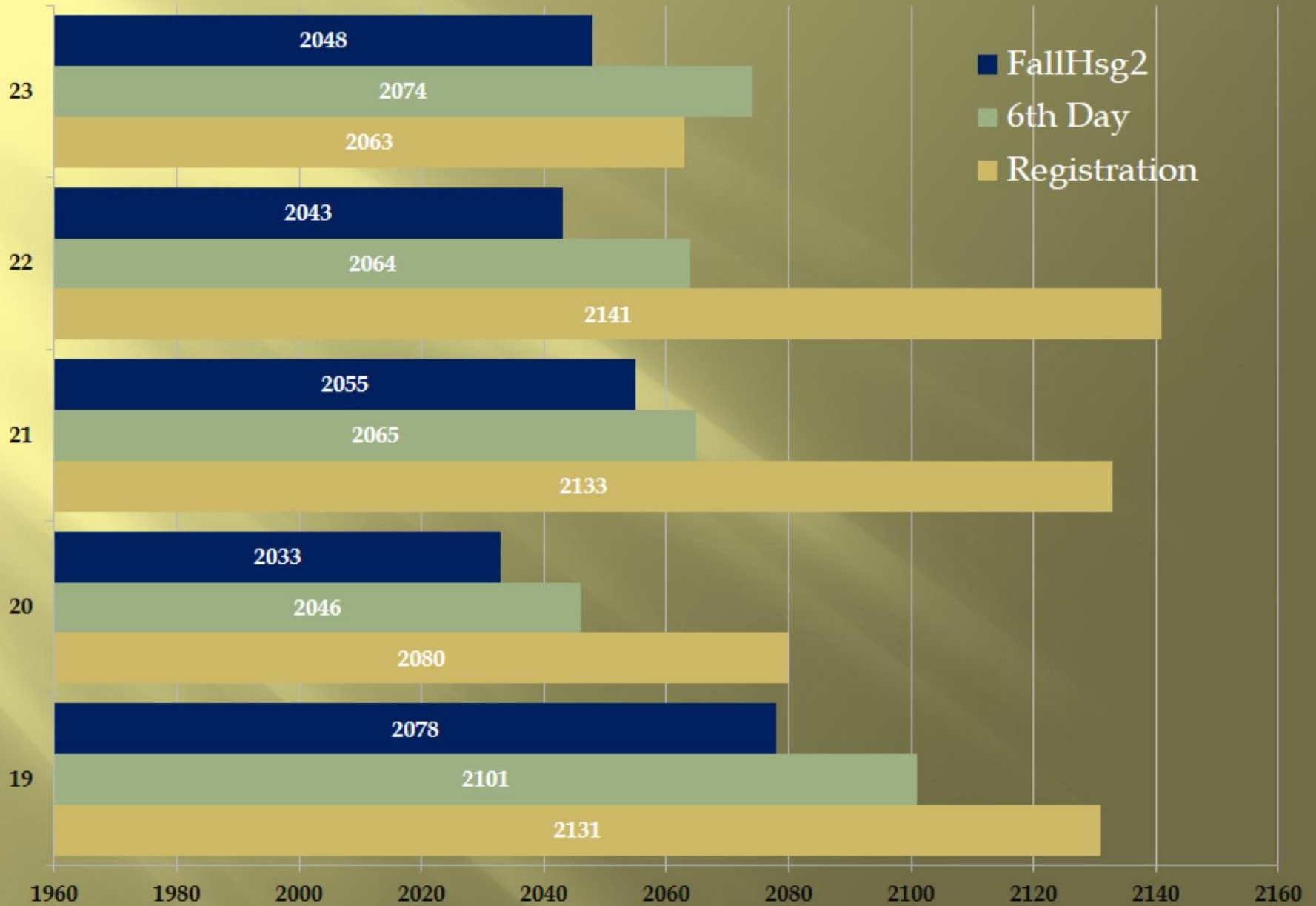
# Student Data

- More than half of the students participated in athletics or activities. (Graph 3)
- The drop-out rate for District 94 is below the State average. (Graph 4)
- At West Chicago Community High School number of Limited English Proficient students is more than the State average and represents the largest percentage of the student population for any school in DuPage County. (Graph 6)
- Grade distributions have fluctuated over the last six years. (Graph 12)
- The graduation rate at District 94 averages around 90% over 5 years. (Graph 16)
- At the end of the 2022-23 school year, 67.73% of graduates planned on attending college. (Graph 17)
- Parent attendance at Parent-Teacher Conferences is notably higher in the fall than in the spring. (Graphs 18-19)

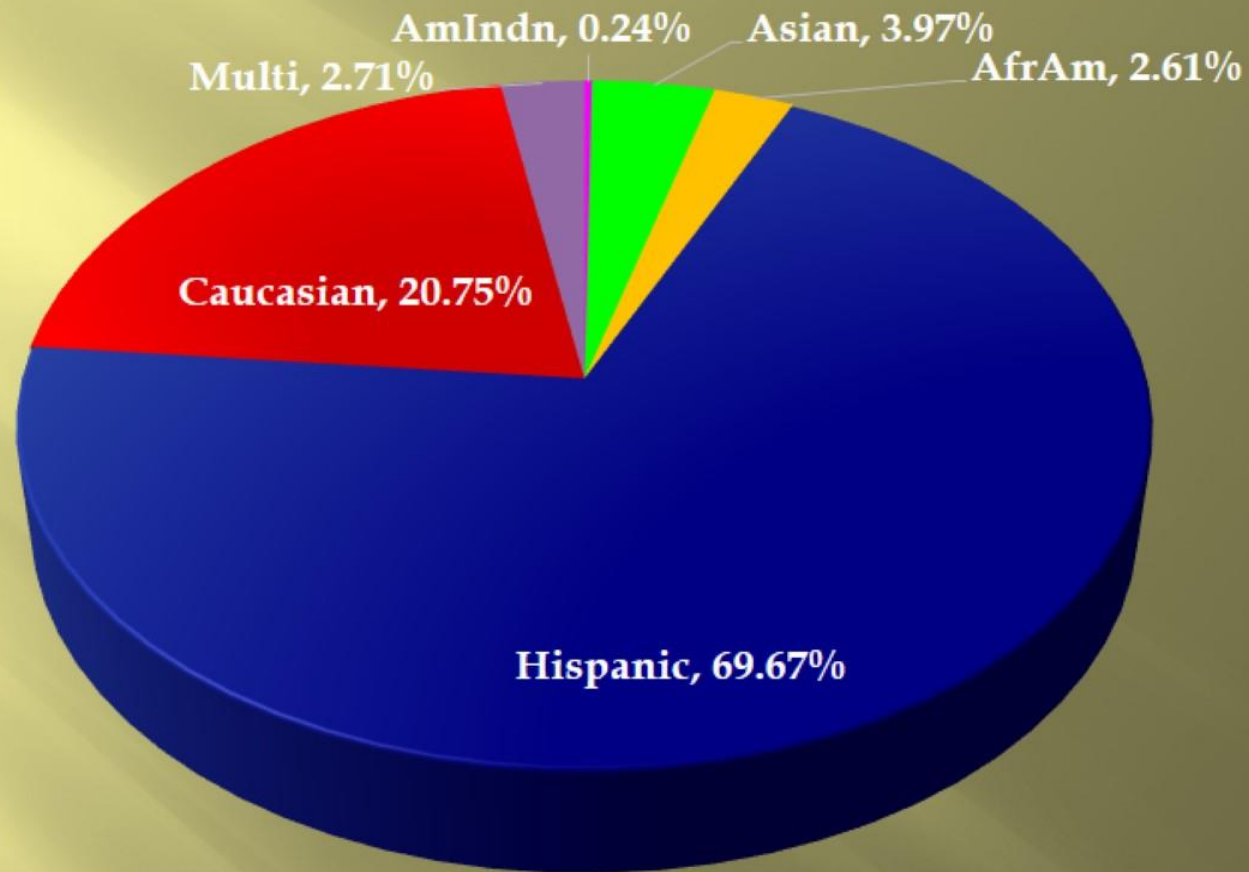

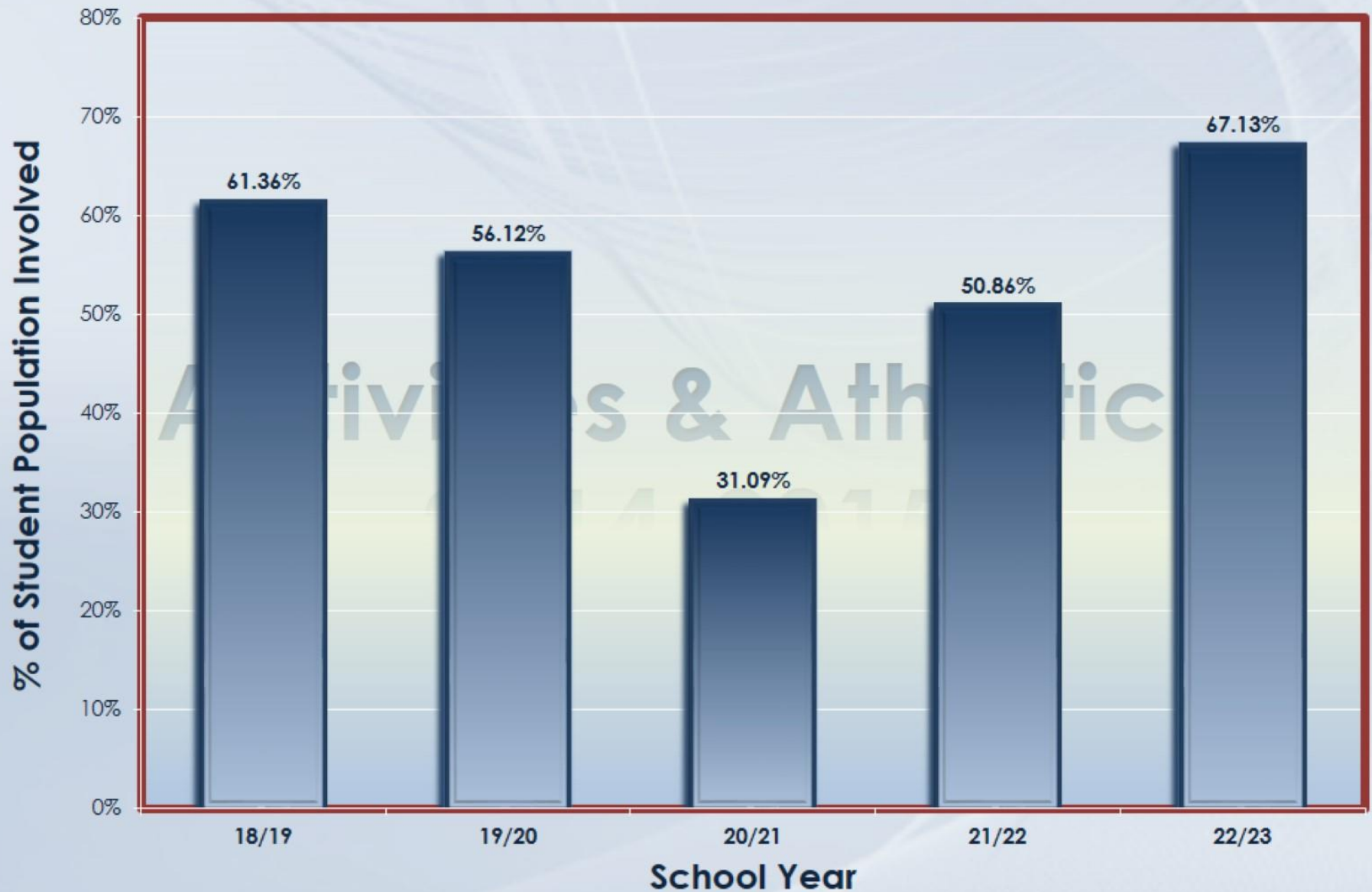

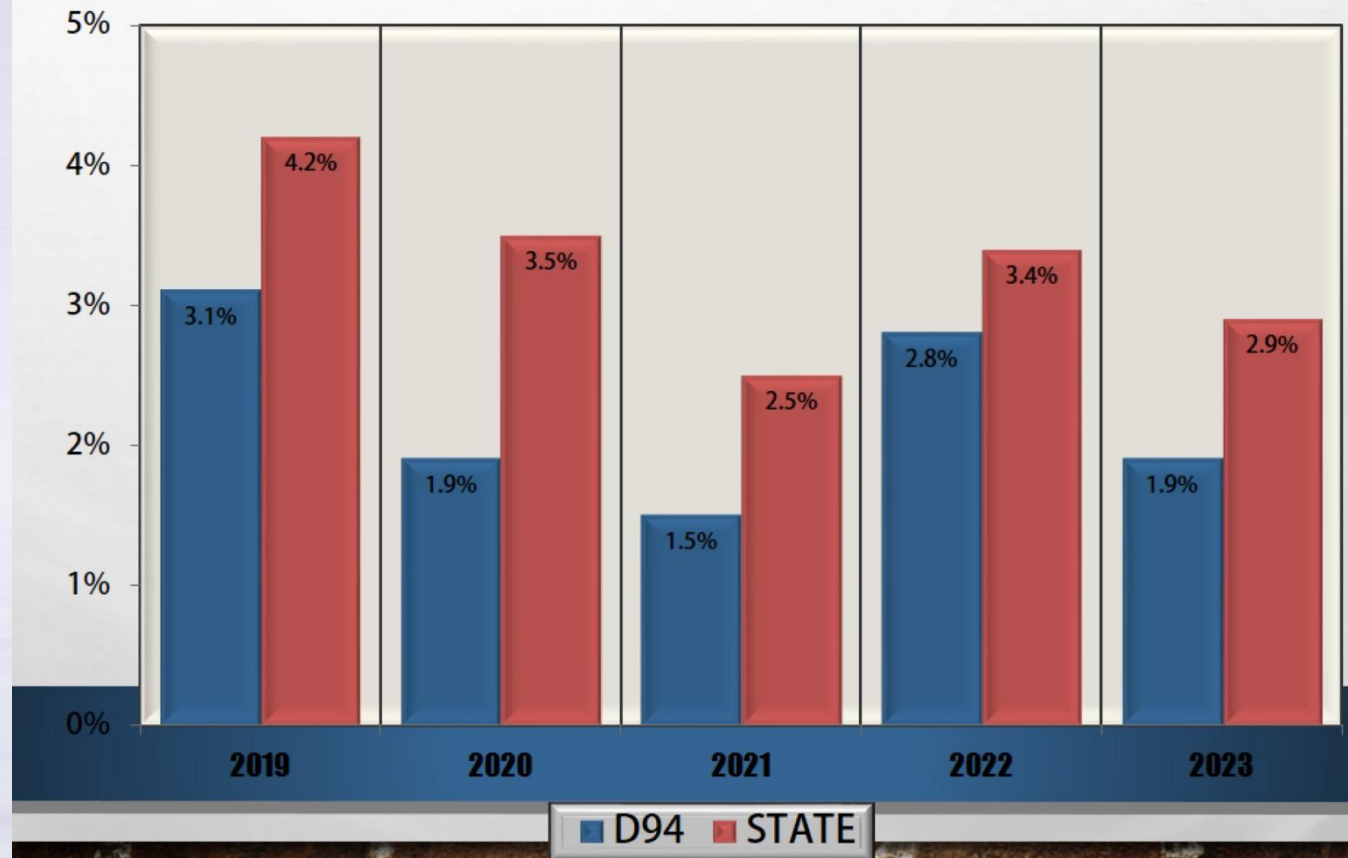

A “drop-out” also includes any student considered to be transferring but for whom a transcript request was not received. The definition does not include expulsions.

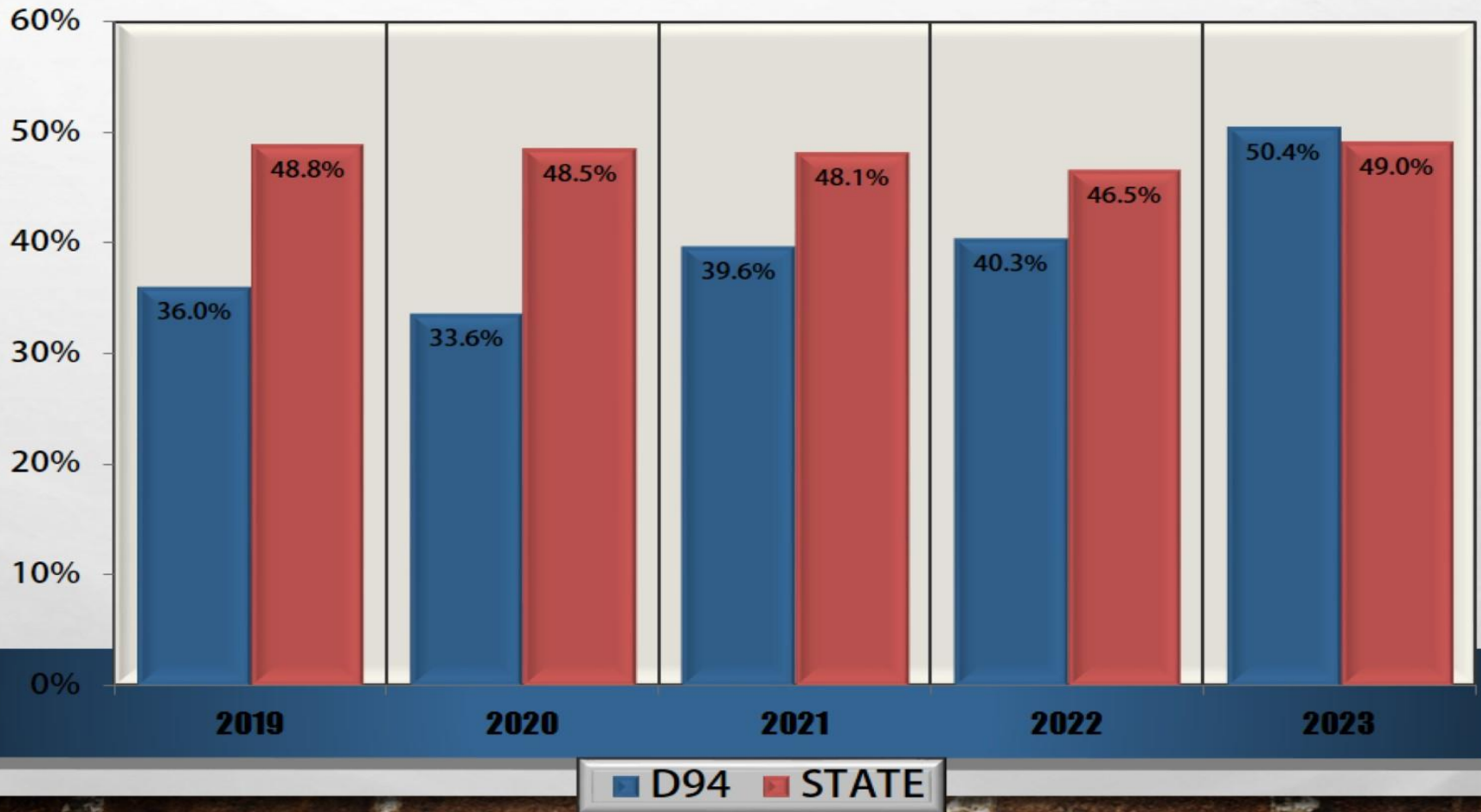
## CHSD 94 Drop Out Rate vs. State



Comment: The drop-out rate for CHS is below the State average every year.



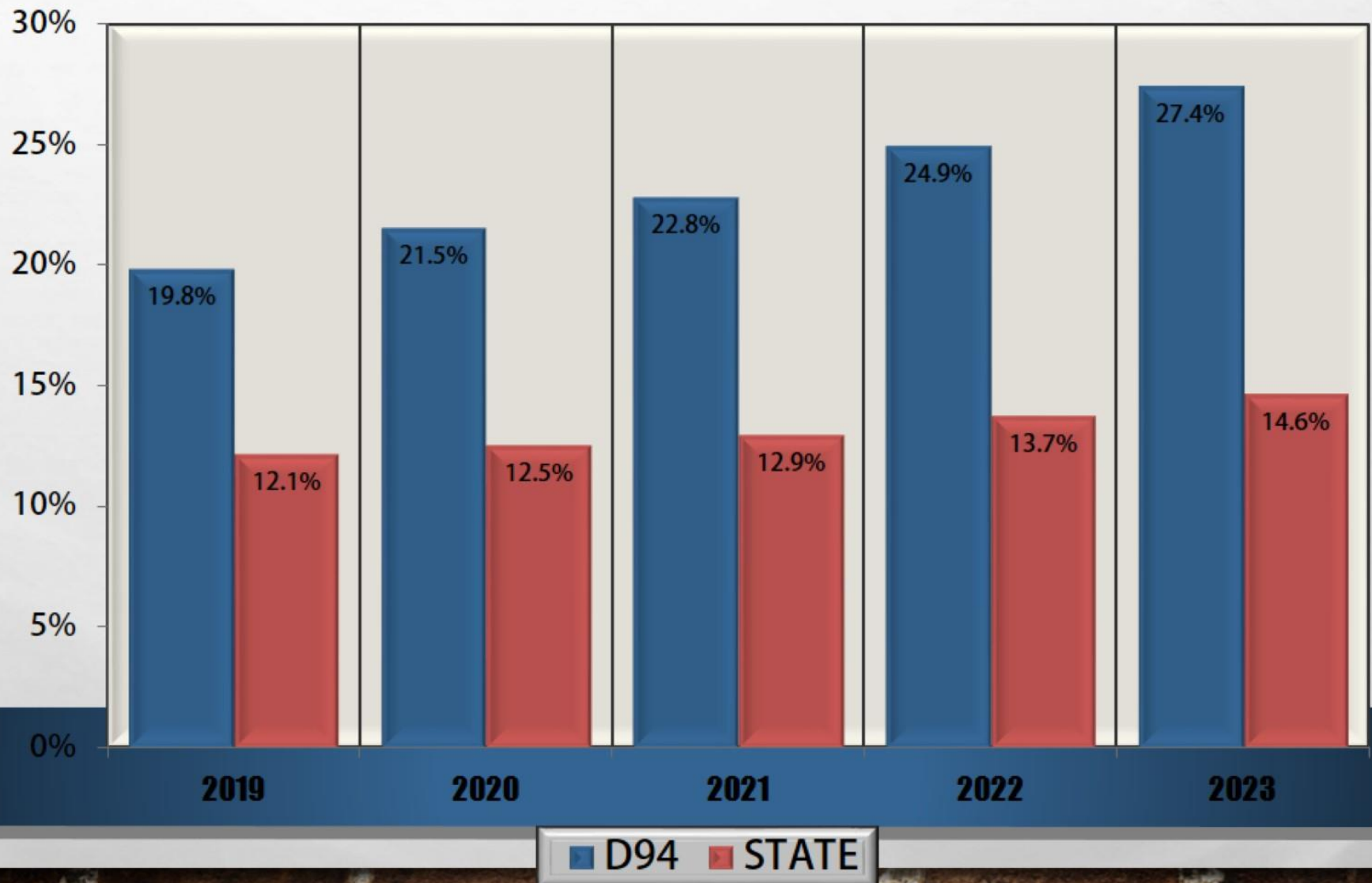
## CHSD 94 Low Income Students vs. State



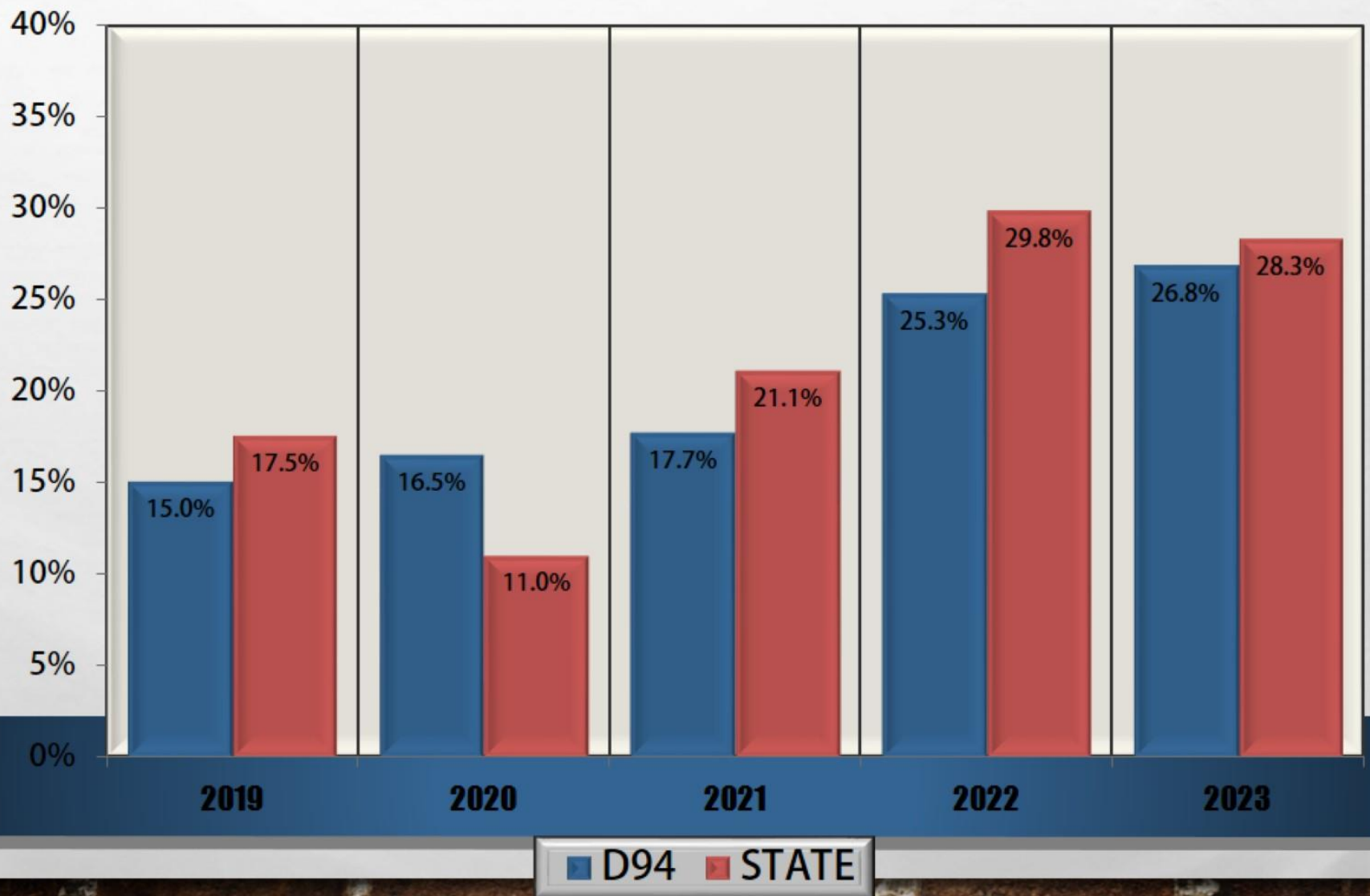

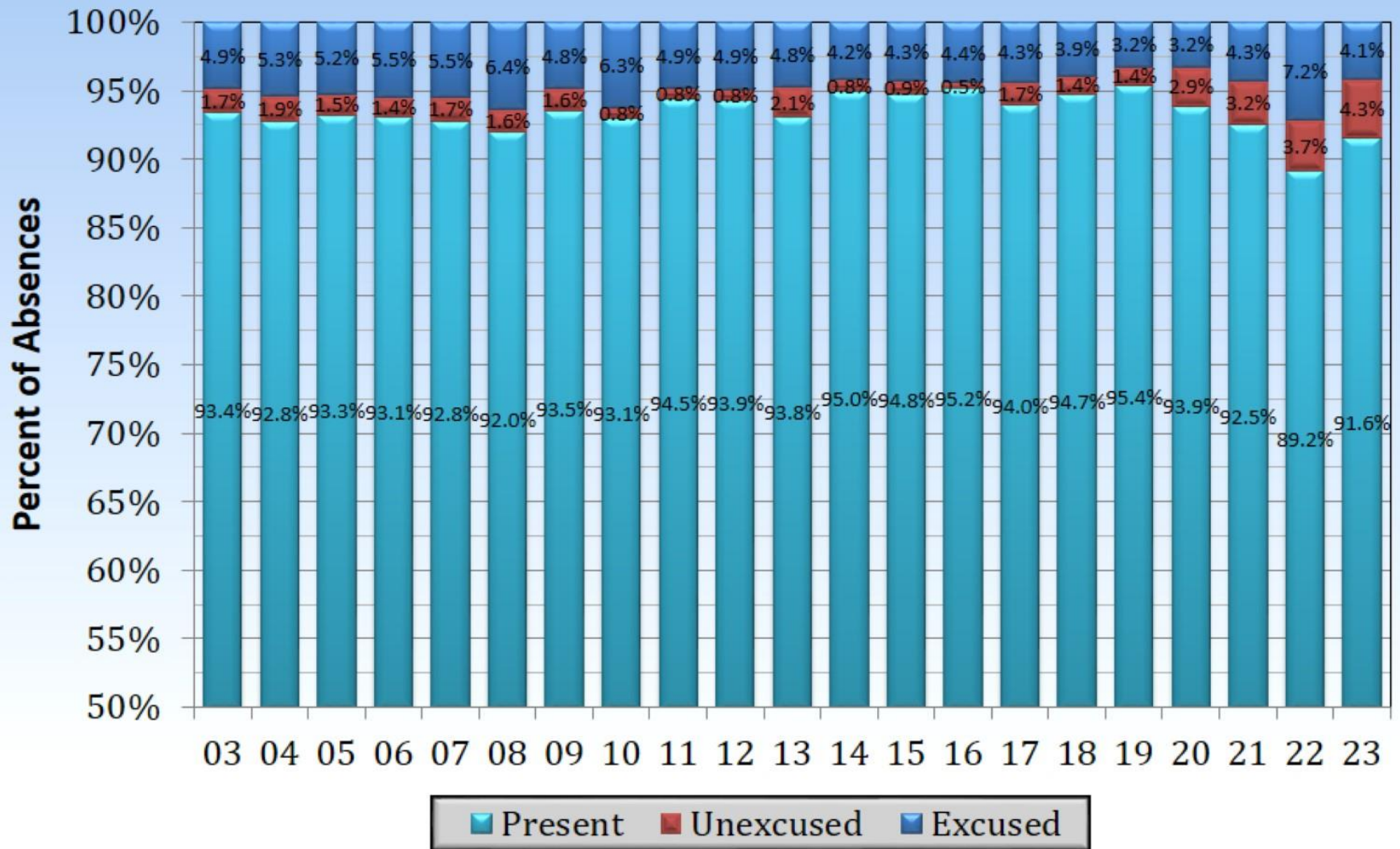


## CHSD 94 Chronic Absent Rate vs. State



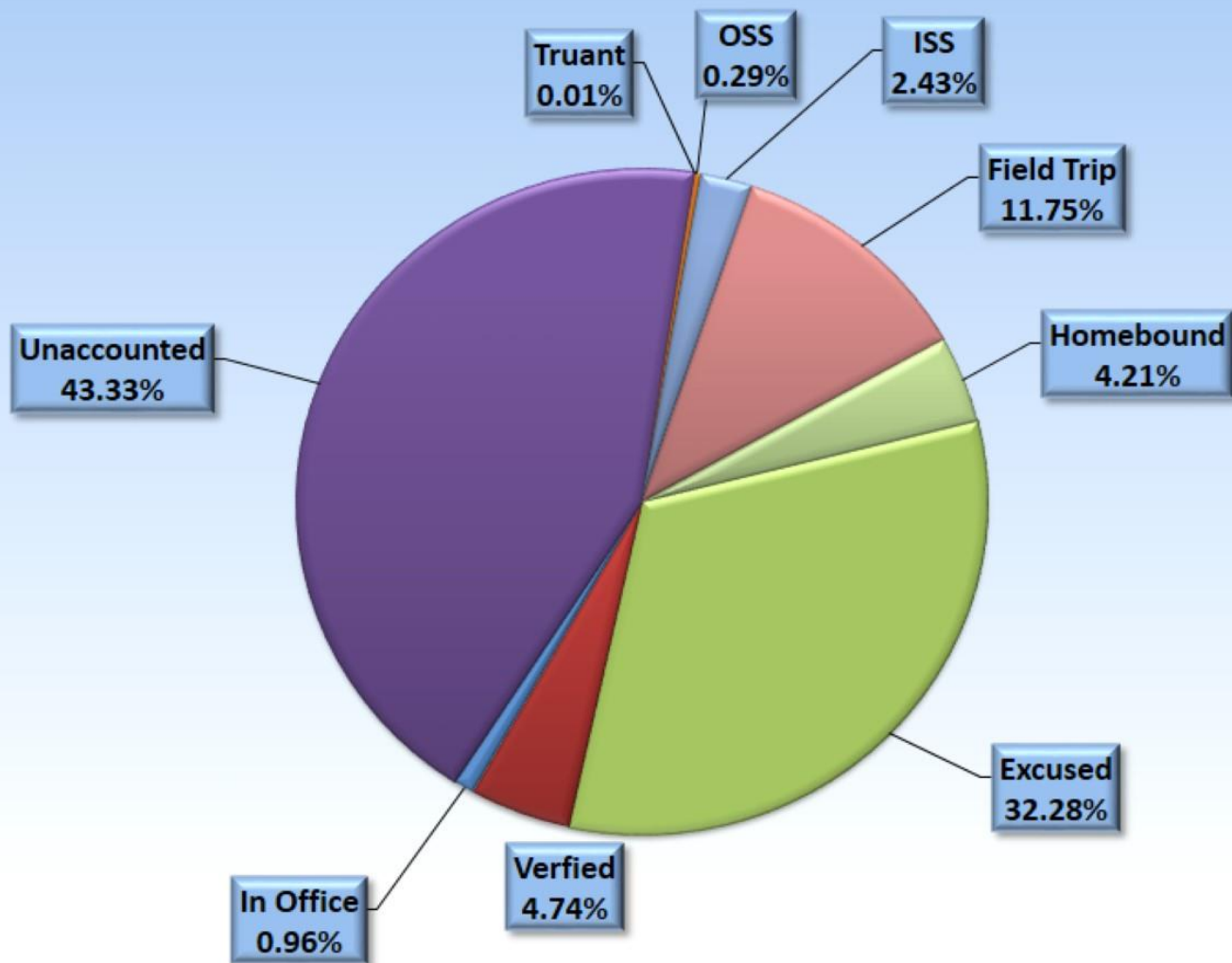
# Attendance by School Year

## Excused vs. Unexcused



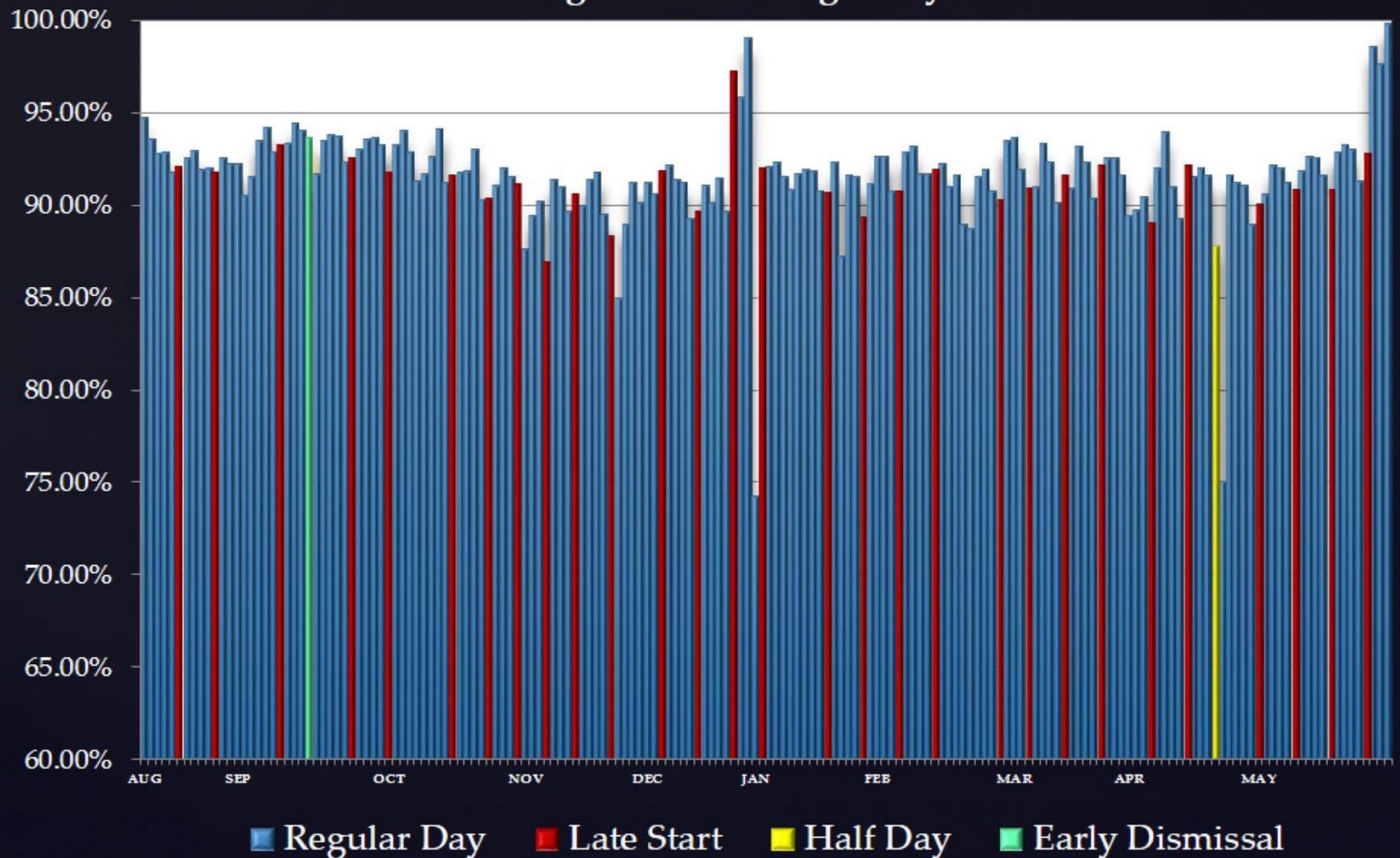
# Absence by Type 2022/2023

August 2022 through May 2023

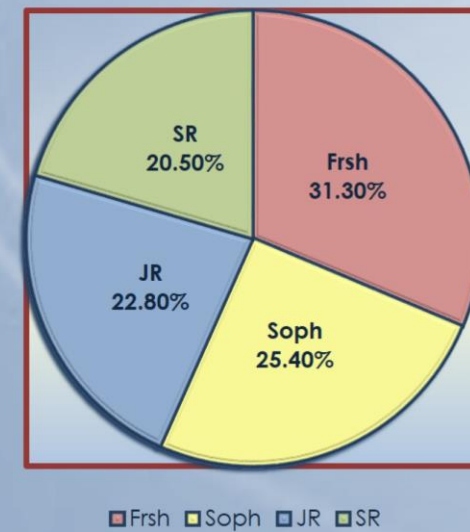




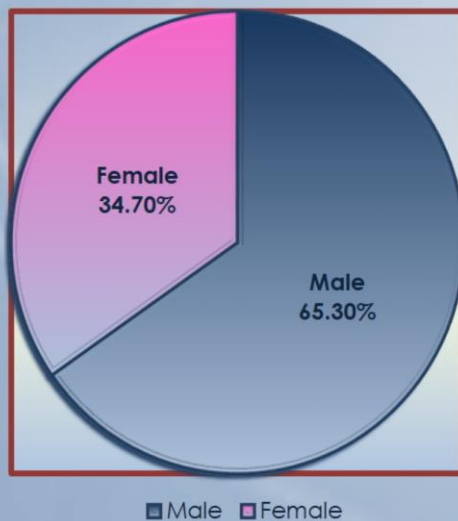

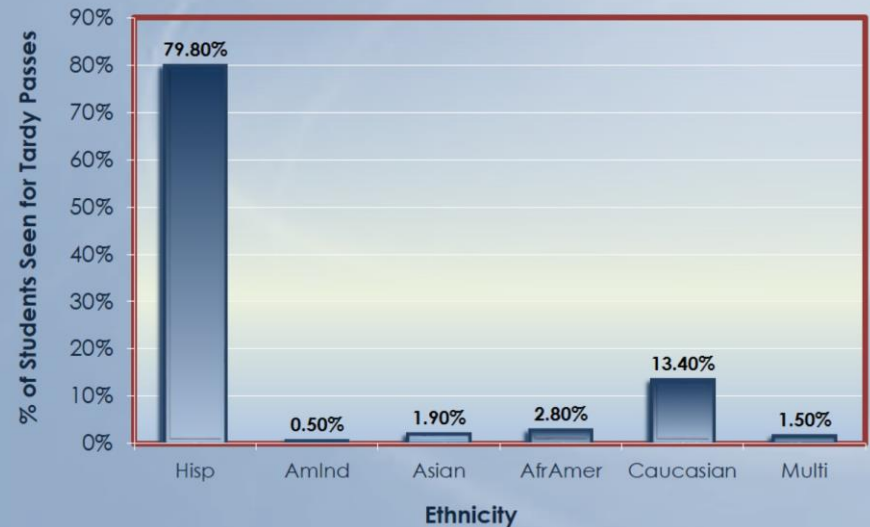
**School Year 2022/2023**

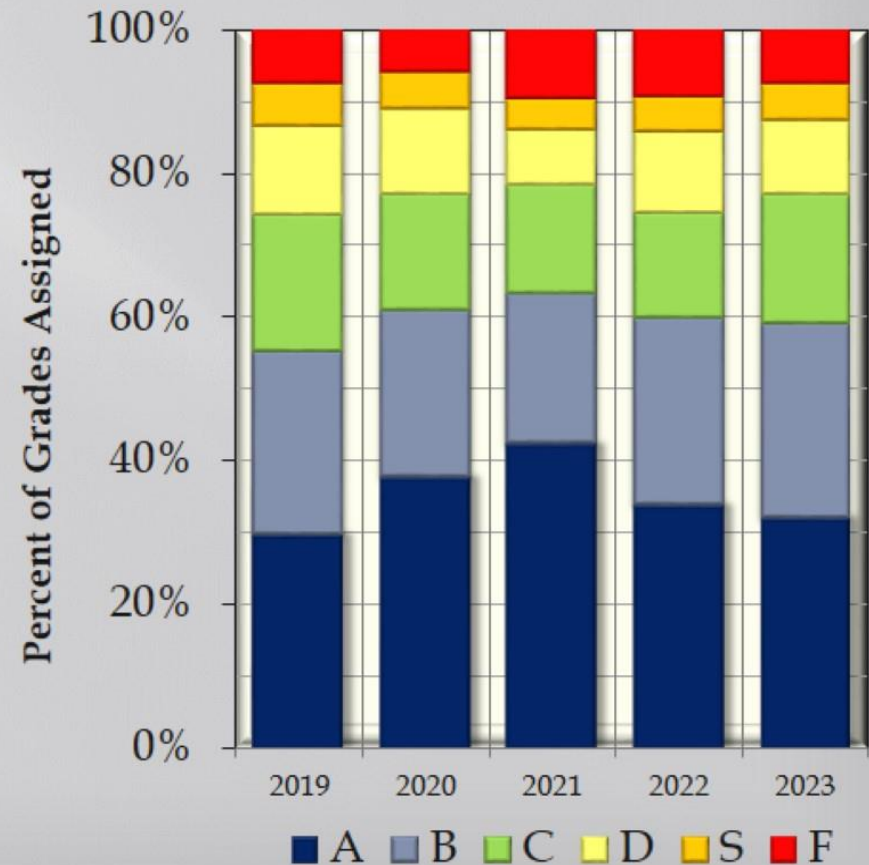

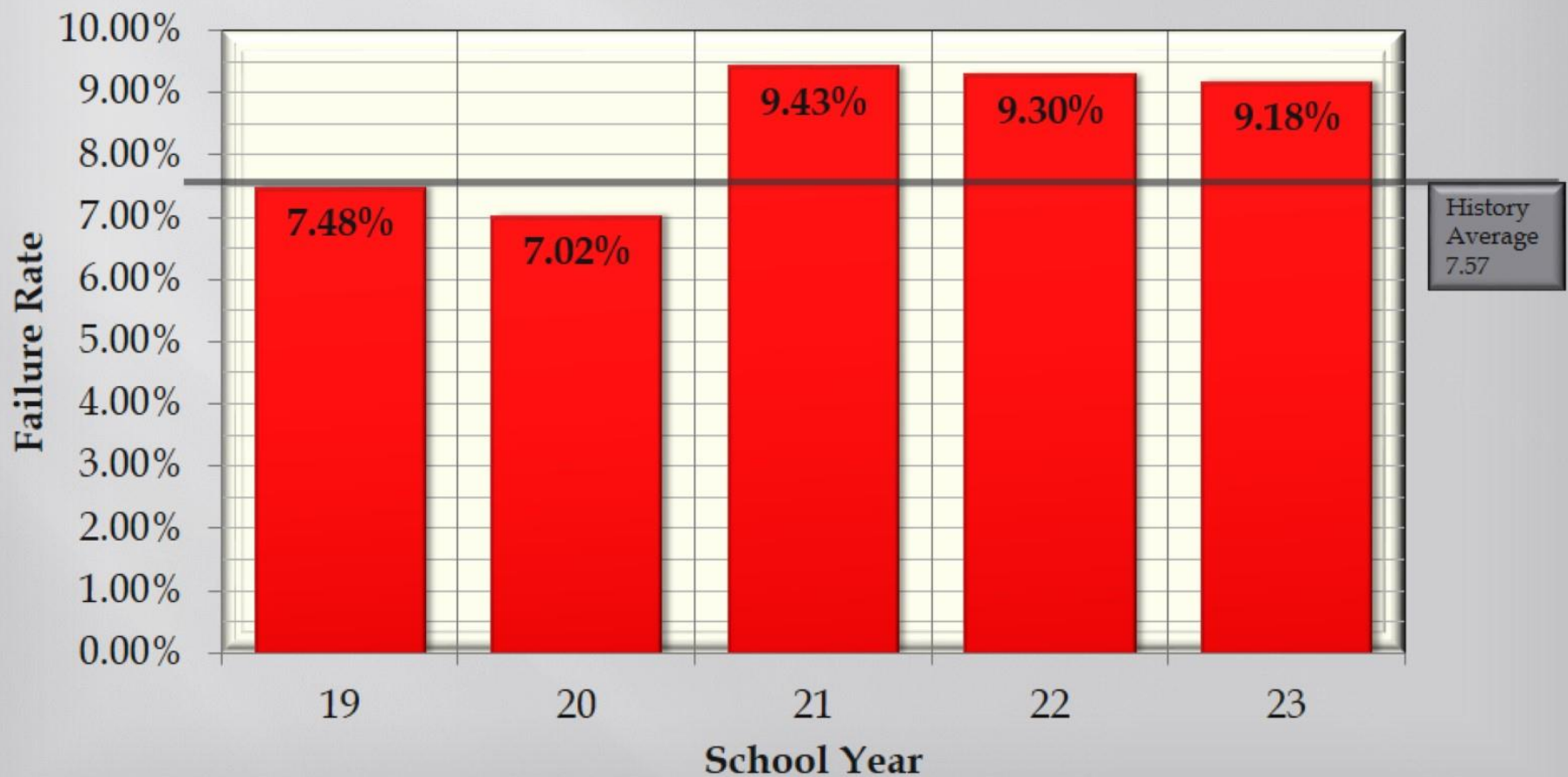

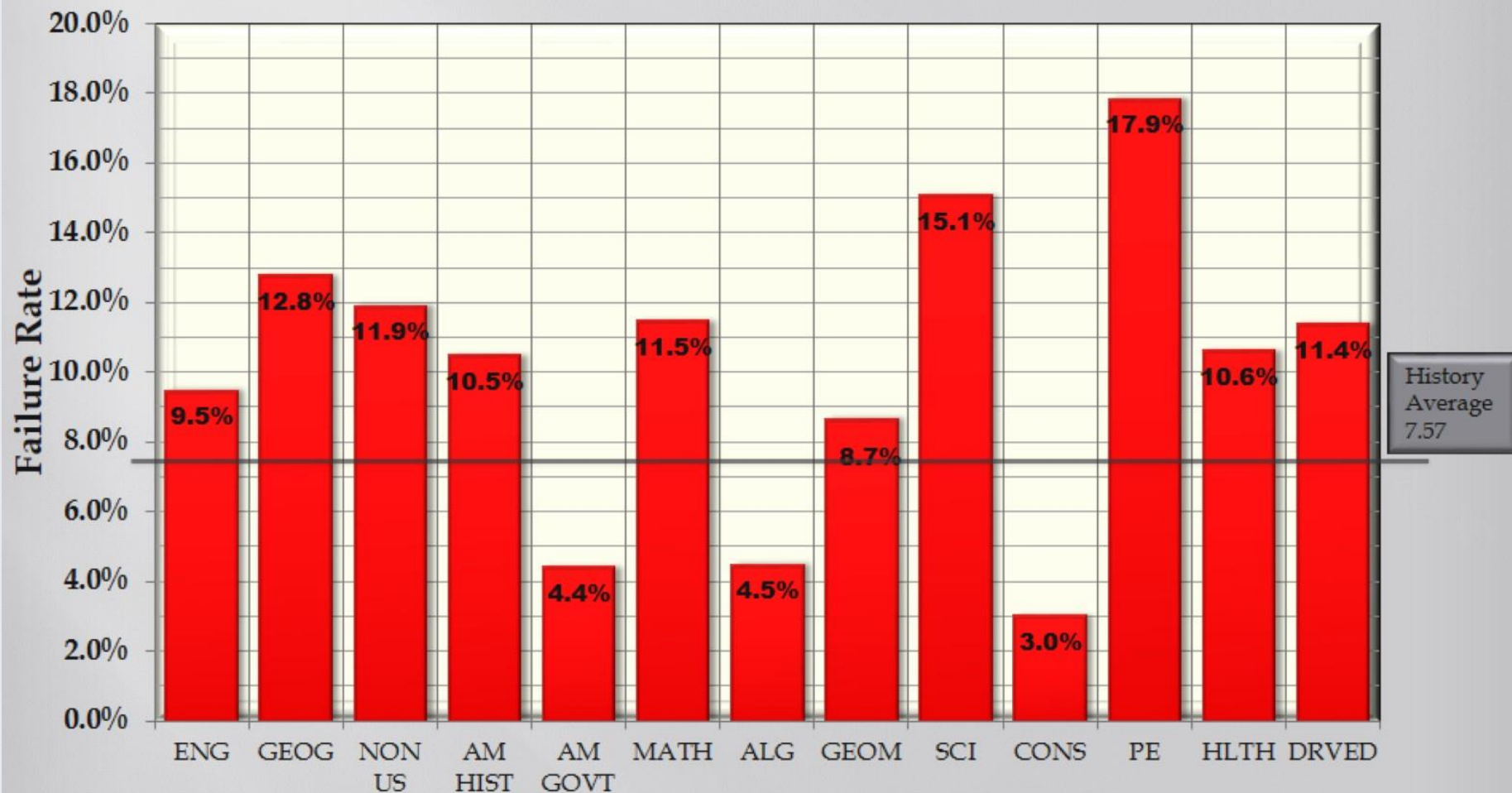
# of Failing Grades Assigned vs Total # of Grades Assigned



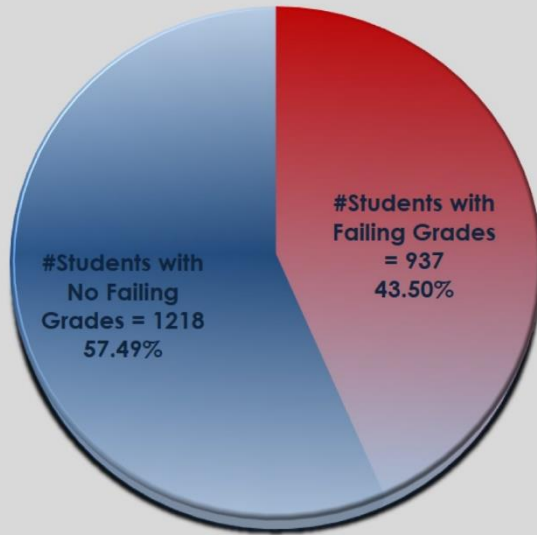
# School Year - 2022/2023

by Graduation Requirement

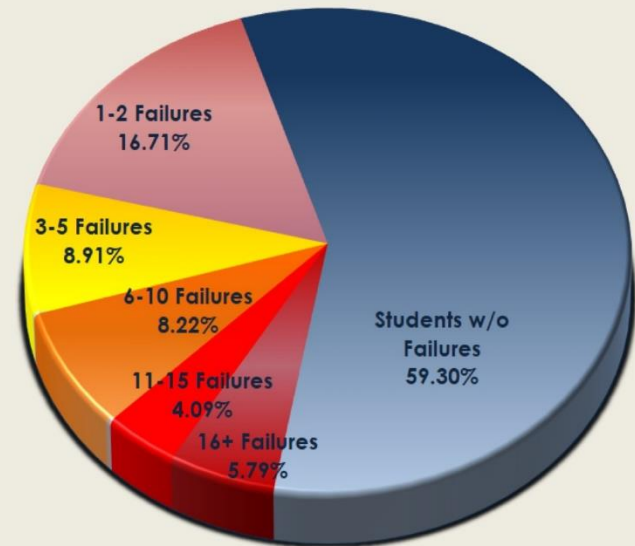
# of Failing Grades Assigned vs Total # of Grades Assigned



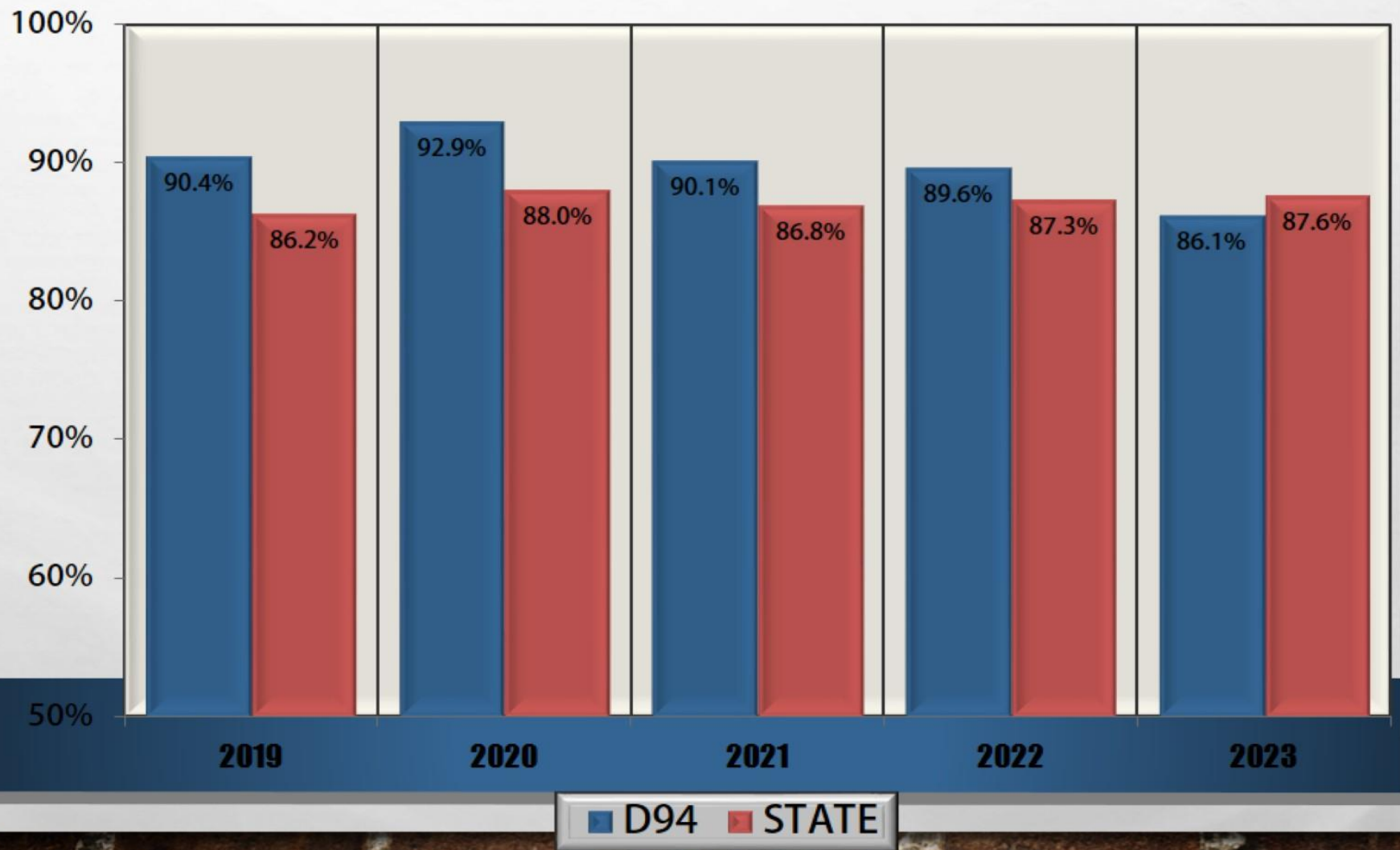

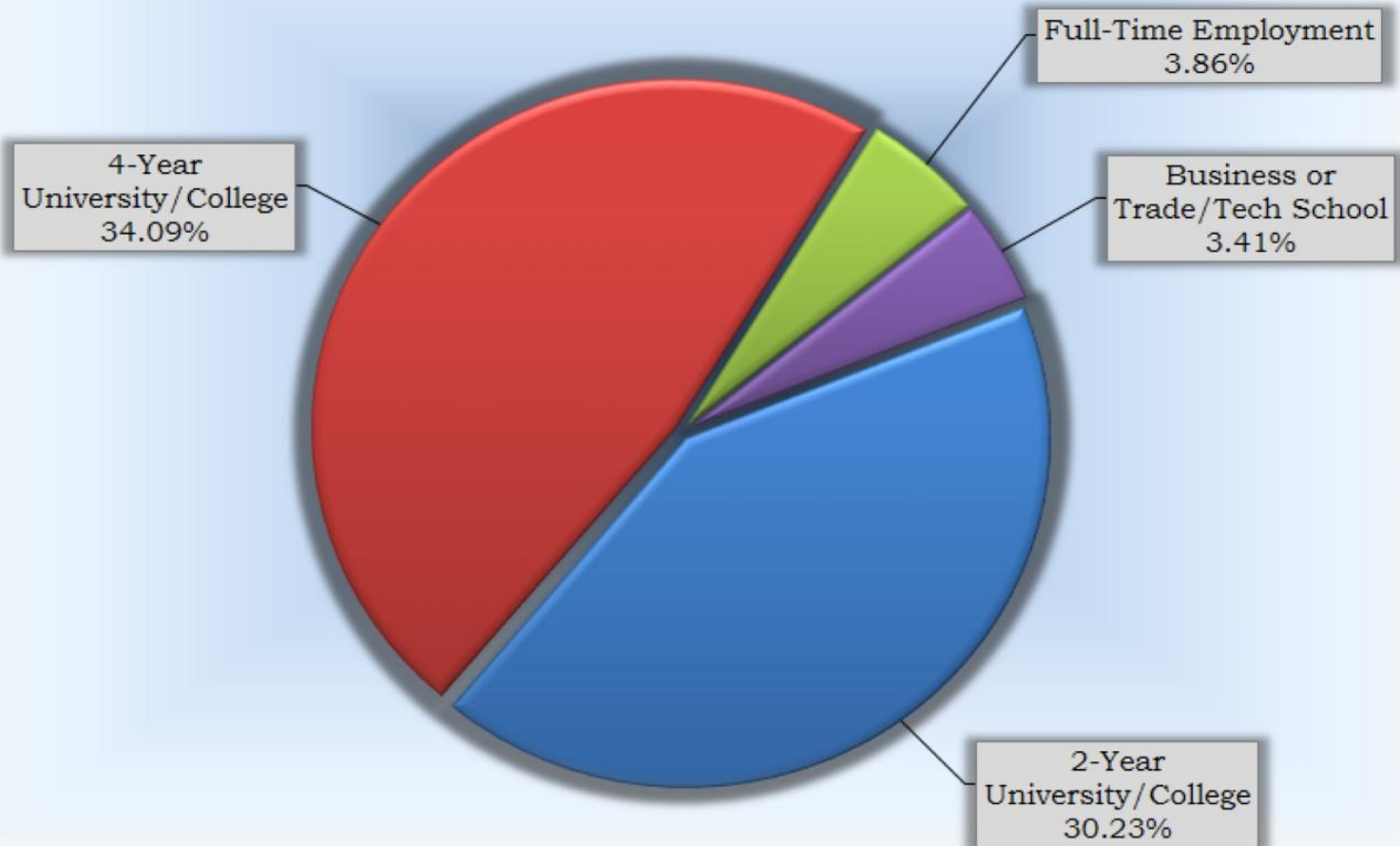

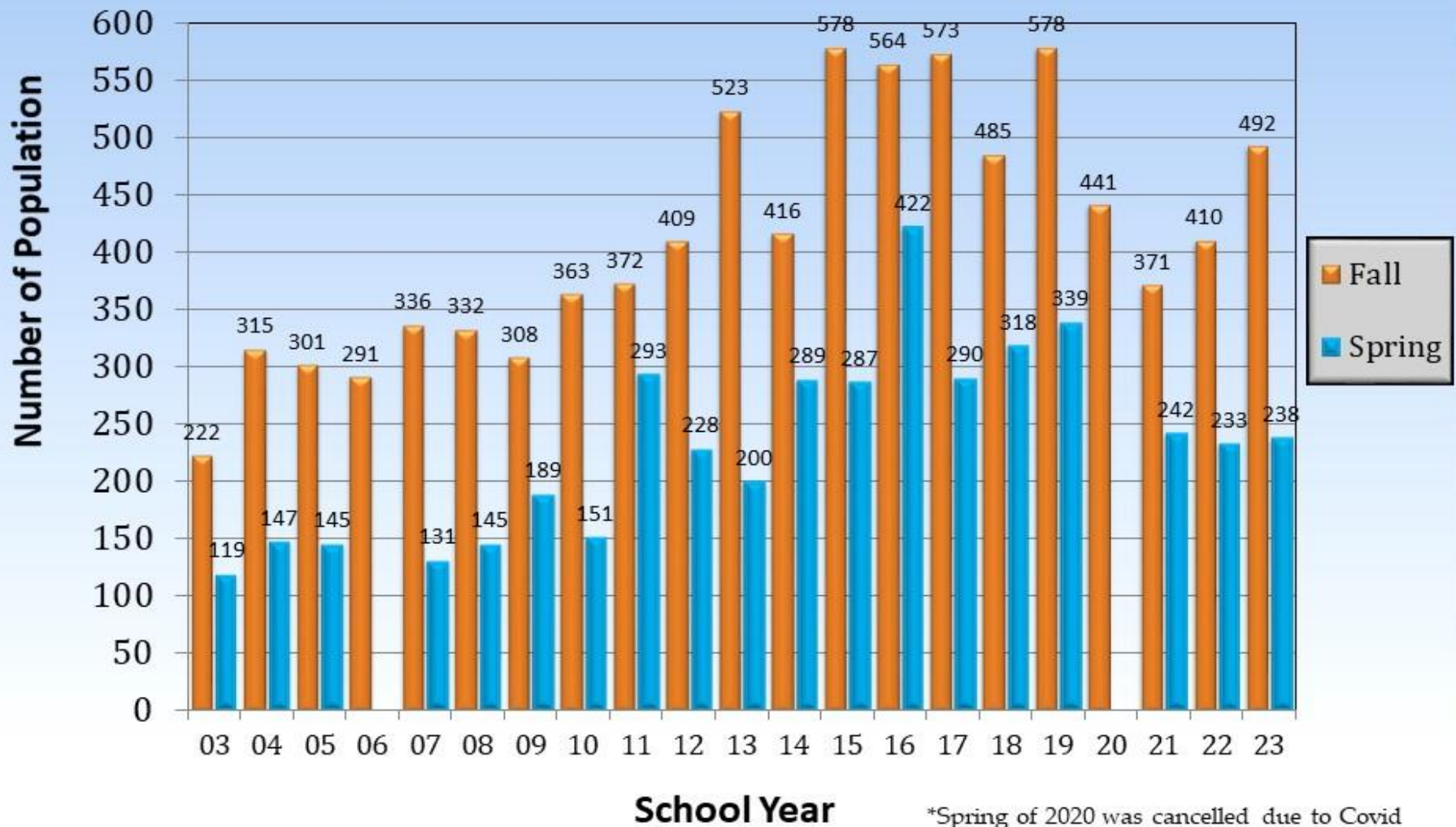

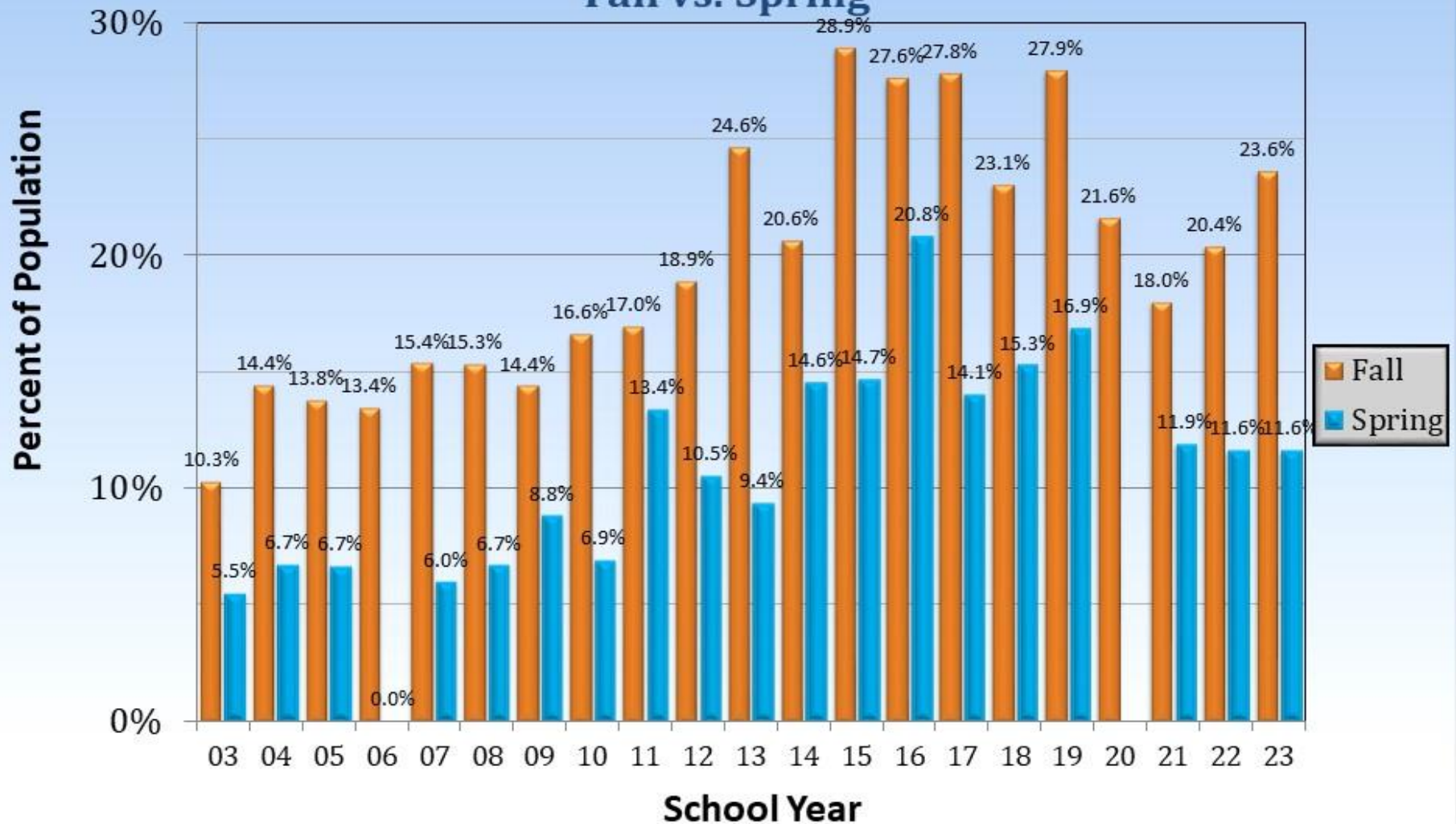
### Fall vs. Spring

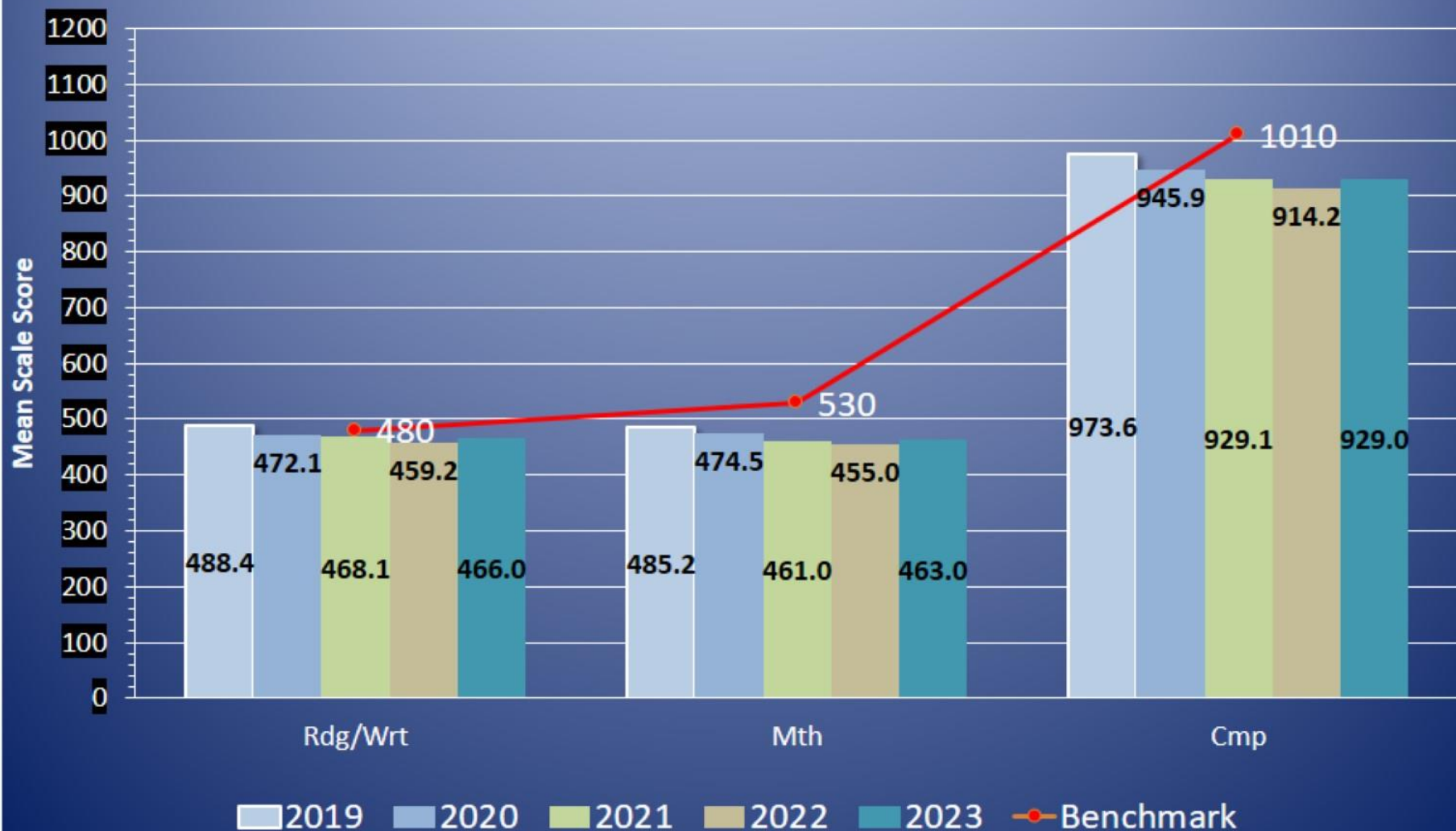

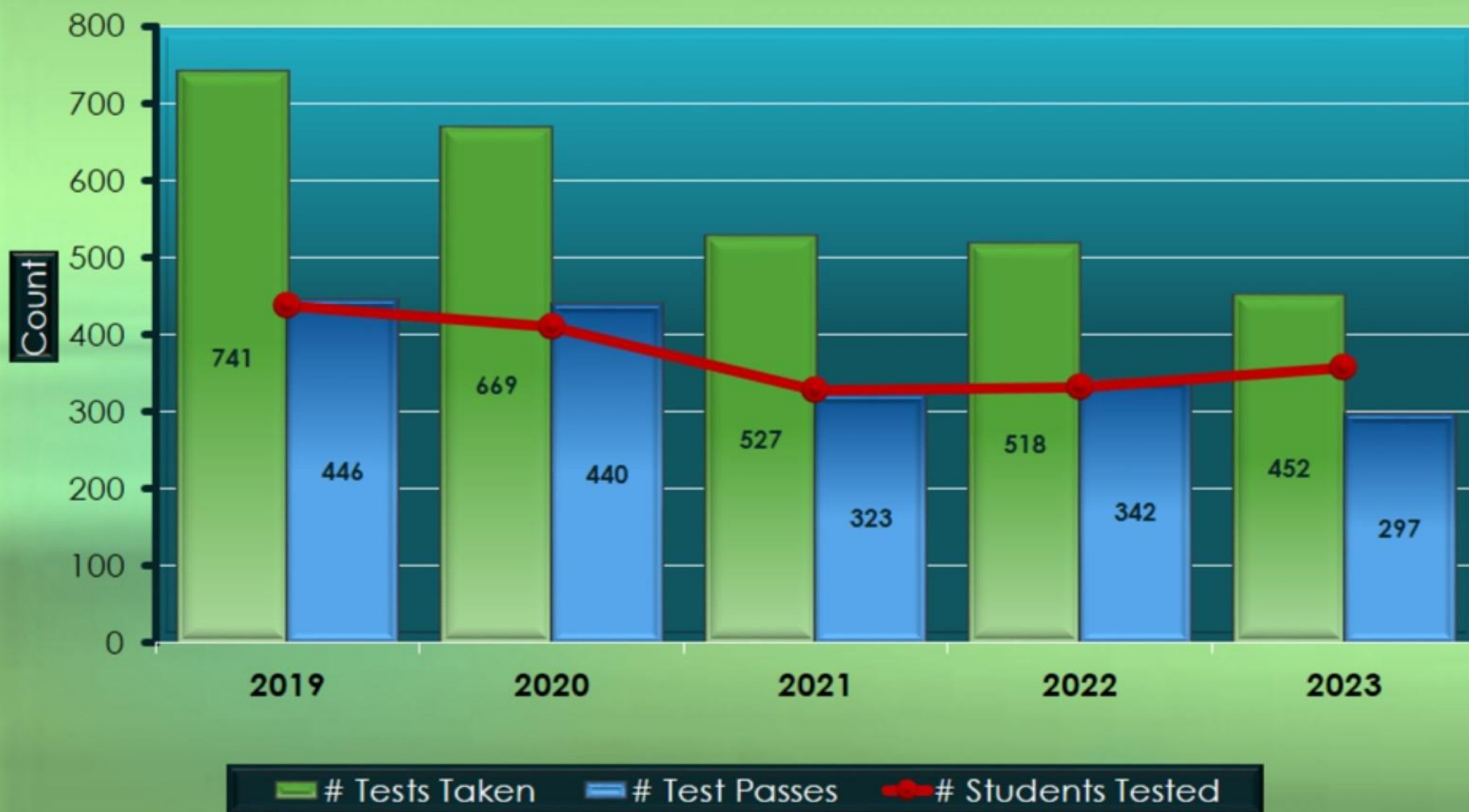

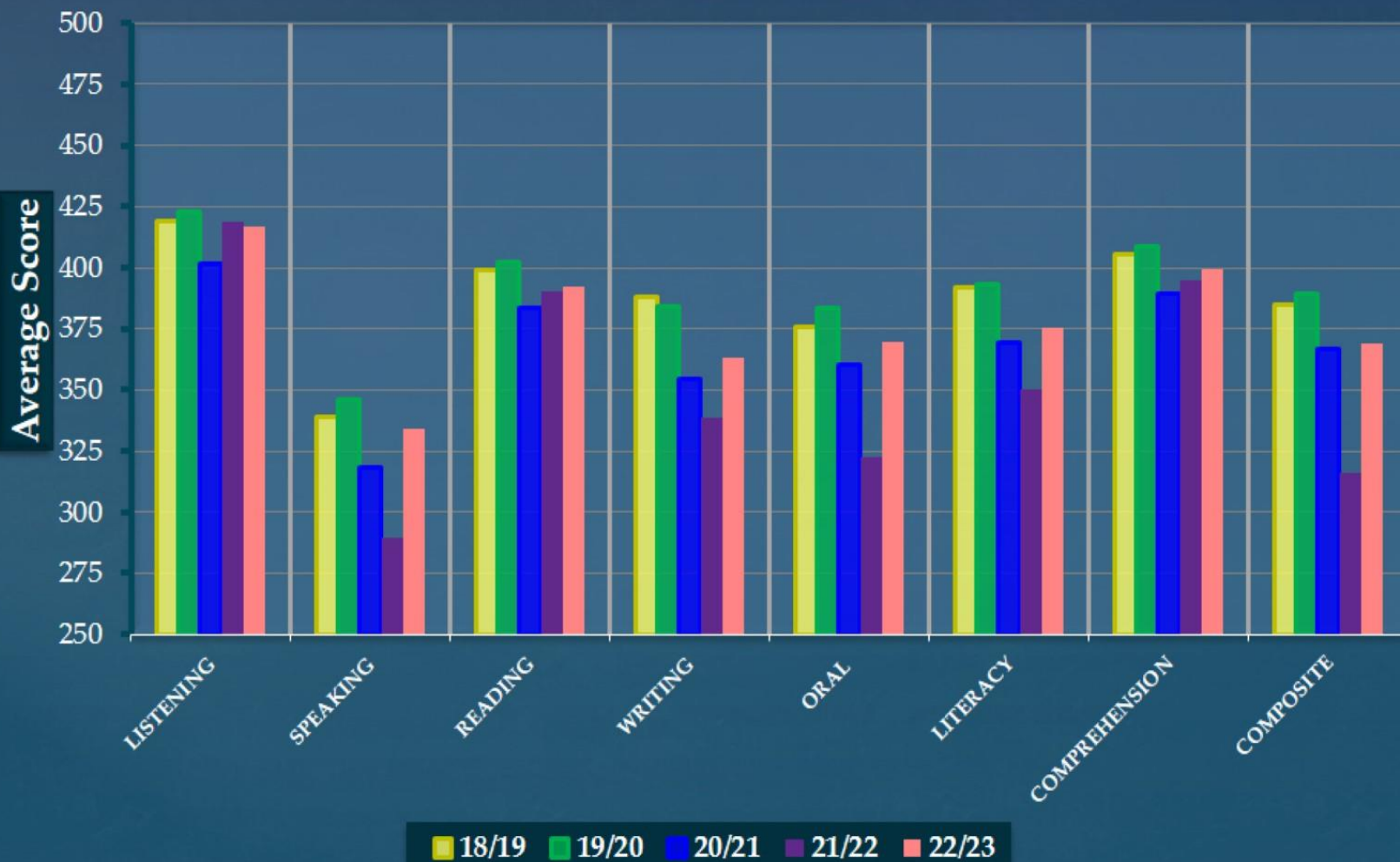

School Year 2018-2023



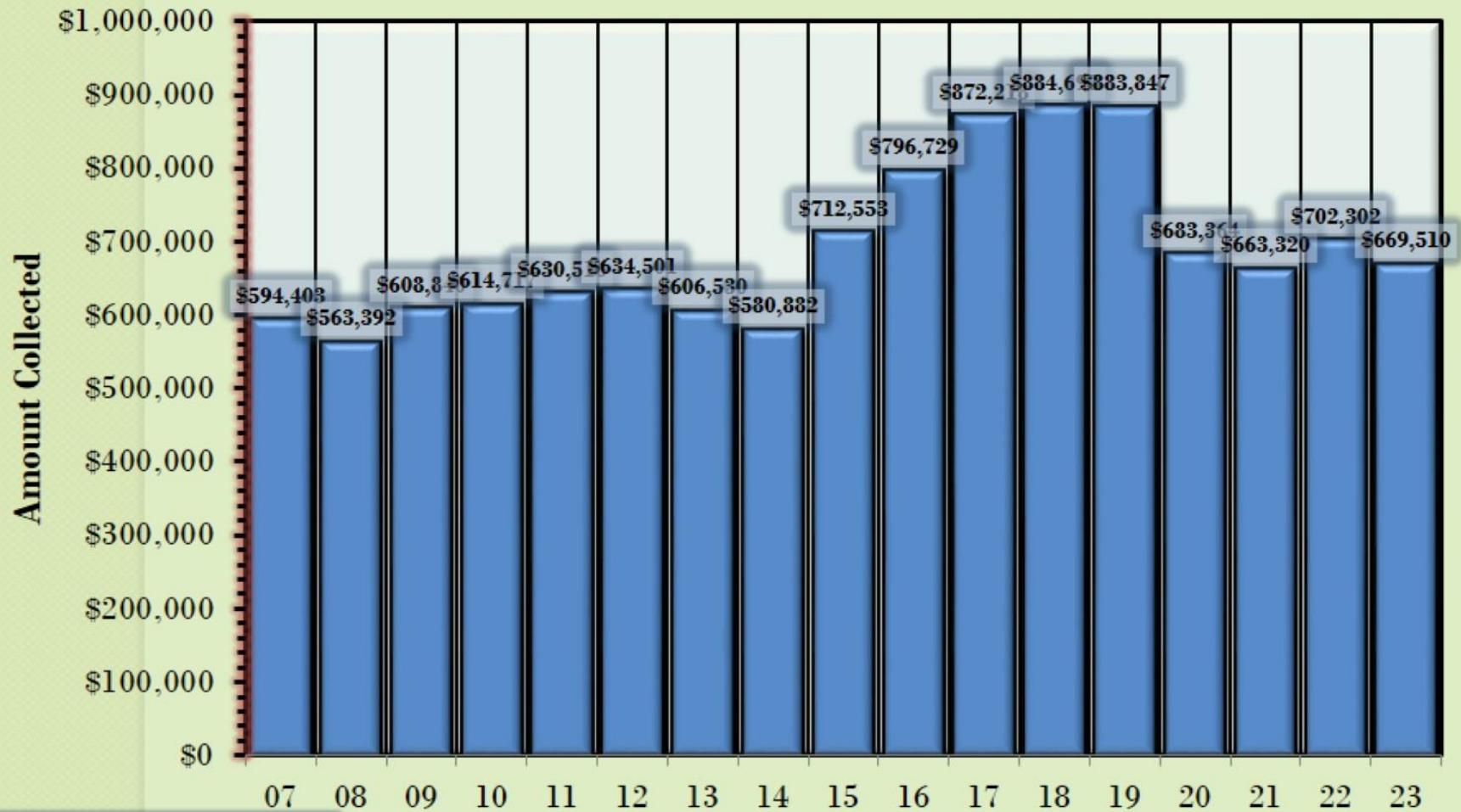
