## EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

For low-income rental households financially impacted by COVID-19.

### RECEIVE A 1-TIME GRANT TOWARDS YOUR RENT!

Amherst Community Development is assisting income-qualifying\* renters at threat of eviction with a one-time grant (up to \$6,000) towards back rent owed. Eligible applicants must be:

- Renters within the Town of Amherst or Village of Williamsville; and,
- Have household income at or below 80% of Erie County's Area Median Income; and,
- Are unemployed or under-employed due to the COVID-19 crisis.
