Congratulations Retirees!

- February 28 was the deadline for teachers to submit letter of resignation for the purposes of retirement.
- Celebration of career to come!
- District received 25 letters of resignation for the purpose of retirement from teachers before the deadline.
- District office and principals have been meeting regularly since the start of budget season to discuss staffing for the 2024-2025 school year.
- This information is presented to the BOE before any seniority-based teacher transfers have been completed. That process begins this month.

- 2022-2023 School Year
 - 7 Faculty Members Added
 - 1 UPK and 15th Grade Teacher at HH based on Summer Registration (Additional Section)
 - 3 SPED Teachers and 1 Speech Teacher
 - 1 HS Reading Teacher

Hiring has Slowed

- 2023-2024 School Year
 - 5 Faculty Members Added all at Elementary Buildings
 - 2 ELL Teachers
 - 1 SPED Teacher
 - 2 Social Workers

Hiring Trends

- 2018-19 School Year to the 2021-2022 School Year
 - 51.7 Faculty Positions Added
- 2022-2023 School Year to 2023-2024 School Year
 - 12 Faculty Positions Added (10 PPS positions in Elementary Buildings)
 - Addition of full-day UPK (8 sections), 1 EC Classroom, 54 ELL students in 2023, and additional enrollment across all buildings.
- Approximate \$1.8 Million in Savings Due to Retirements/Consolidations

- Taylor Nugent placed 2nd in the state for race walk with a personal best.



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
