# PROGRAM NOTES

Our **Choir**'s performance begins with '**Clap Your Hands and Sing**,' a jubilant celebration of music's power to uplift and unite. We've added our own percussive clapping section in the middle of the piece! Following that is '**The Old Mill**,' a poem about a man's reminiscence of his youth while visiting an old mill, symbolizing the passage of time and the continuity of life. Finally, we conclude our set with the uplifting '**Everything Sings**,' exploring the interconnectedness of life and music.

Our **Jazz Band**'s set pays homage to the legendary Duke Ellington with the smooth melodies and laid-back groove of '**In a Mellow Tone**,' as well as the exciting, up-tempo samba of '**Caravan**.' Between these pieces, we'll perform '**Red's Good Groove**,' channeling the infectious energy and charisma of jazz pianist Red Garland. All students have worked hard to solo over all three of these pieces, and we're featuring as many as we can this evening!

The **Intermediate Band** will perform one of my favorite works for early bands, Brian Balmages's '**Midnight Suite**.' He wrote the first movement, '**Midnight Mission**,' to evoke the fun and excitement of childhood games. The second movement, '**Midnight Sky**,' was inspired by the miracle of his wife giving birth to their first child. And the suite ends with '**Midnight Madness**,' which was inspired by the chaos of having a newborn in the house!

The **Concert Band**'s performance will capture the beauty and drama of spring through three programmatic works. '**Clouds**' depicts cirrus, thunder, and cumulus clouds using connected legato lines and aleatoric percussion crashes. Following that, '**Spring**' celebrates the season's renewal and the rebirth of nature through vibrant melodies and lush harmonies. Closing their set is '**The Tempest**,' which depicts the tranquil calm before the storm and the tumultuous fury of a tempest unleashed.

To close, the **Wind Ensemble**'s performance will showcase American folk melodies and infectious rhythms. '**Shaker Variants**' is a dynamic exploration of folk melodies and dance rhythms inspired by the Shaker melody, "Simple Gifts." Del Borgo captures the spirit of community and celebration with wide legato phrases and shimmering woodwind lines. '**Balladair**,' written by Spokane native Frank Erickson, is a lyrical and expressive work that showcases the band's beauty and versatility. Through its lush harmonies and heartfelt melodies, this piece invites listeners on a journey of reflection and introspection. Finally, the Wind Ensemble will close with '**Prairie Dances**,' a spirited musical celebration of the American heartland. Alternating between 6/8 and 3/4, this fast-paced dance is sure to excite you!"
