

Resolution Authorizing \$1.5 Million of Bond Funds for Upgrading the Pontiac School District Center for Swimming and Aquatic Training

****Whereas****, the Pontiac School District is committed to providing comprehensive educational and extracurricular opportunities for its students;

****Whereas****, swimming and aquatic training are valuable skills that promote physical health, safety, and overall well-being;

****Whereas****, the existing facilities at the Pontiac School District Center require significant upgrades to meet current educational standards and to be fully functional for swimming and aquatic training programs;

****Whereas****, the district has access to bond funds specifically designated for improving educational facilities;

****Therefore, Be It Resolved****:

1. The Pontiac School District Board of Education authorizes the allocation of \$1.5 million from the **district's bond or ESSR** funds for the purpose of upgrading the Pontiac School District Center to support swimming and aquatic training for its students.
2. The allocated funds will be used for necessary renovations and improvements, including but not limited to:
 - Refurbishing and modernizing the swimming pool and surrounding facilities.
 - Upgrading locker rooms, shower areas, and other support facilities.
 - Installing new safety equipment and accessibility features.
 - Enhancing the HVAC system and other infrastructure to ensure a safe and comfortable environment.
3. The district administration will oversee the planning, procurement, and execution of the renovation project, ensuring that all expenditures are in compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and district policies.

4. The district administration will regularly report to the School Board on the progress of the renovation project, including updates on timelines, budgets, and any challenges encountered.

5. The district will engage with students, staff, and the community to gather input and feedback throughout the renovation process, ensuring that the upgraded facilities meet the needs and expectations of all stakeholders.

6. The district will ensure that the upgraded swimming and aquatic training facilities are integrated into the physical education curriculum and extracurricular programs, providing students with access to high-quality aquatic training and safety education.
