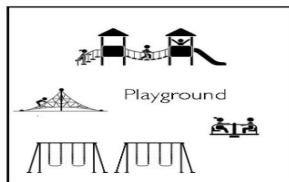
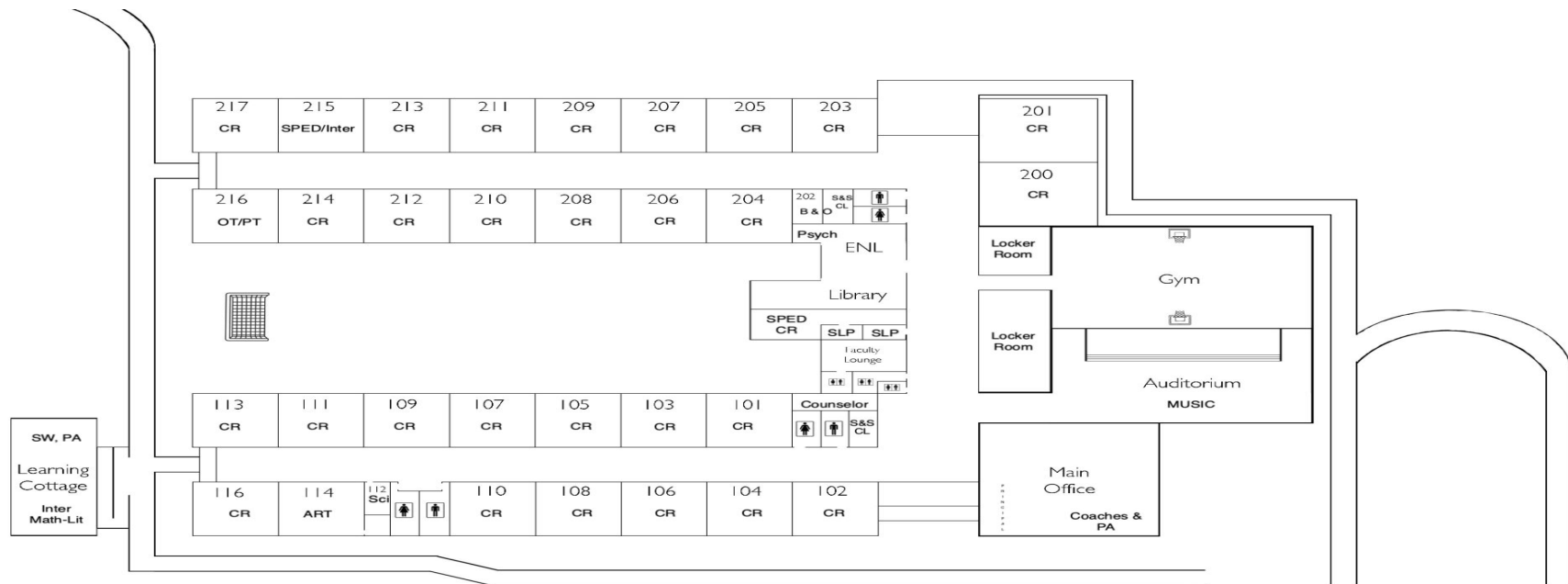

# Focus Areas at Maplemere

## ★ Teacher Rounds starting in March

- Teams of grade level teachers, interventionists, ENL, SPED
- Create deeper understanding of vertically aligned curriculum.
- Grades 3-5 observe Math; Grades K-2 observe Literacy (Reading, Writing, & Word Study)
  - Does our presentation (not curriculum) look like a progression?
  - Do we share some common best practices? Are there practices that need to be shared?
  - Regardless of the students/teacher, are kids getting an “experience”?
  - Can we make a long term commitment to the work we started 5 years ago?

## ★ Begin to prepare for 23-24

- Primary Focus=Math with coaches & interventionists
- Intermediate Focus=Literacy with with coaches & interventionists

# Maplemere Gratitude-From October 2019 (last traveling BOE visit) to January 2022

## Building Challenges:

- Our intervention (below benchmark) system/resources:
  - K=32%
  - 1=34%
  - 2=33%
  - 3=51%
  - 4=57%
  - 5=57%
- Our ability to meet the social-emotional needs of our students:
  - Mental health curriculum
  - Group/individual counseling
  - Trauma informed care
    - 29 new students moved in since September (Many of our new students are coming with social-emotional needs/trauma.)
- Our students would benefit from an academic support program outside of the school day (homework & reading).

## ★ Students below benchmark (WTW & BAS):

K-36%	+4%
1-45%	+11% (13 new students)
2-20%	-13%
3-30%	-21%
4-36%	-21%
5-37%	-20%

- ★ Added a social worker & full time school psychologist to meet the social-emotional needs of students.
- ★ District & BOE supported after school intervention program in 2020-2021 & 2021-2022
  - These resources have provided a tremendous amount of supports to our students & staff.
