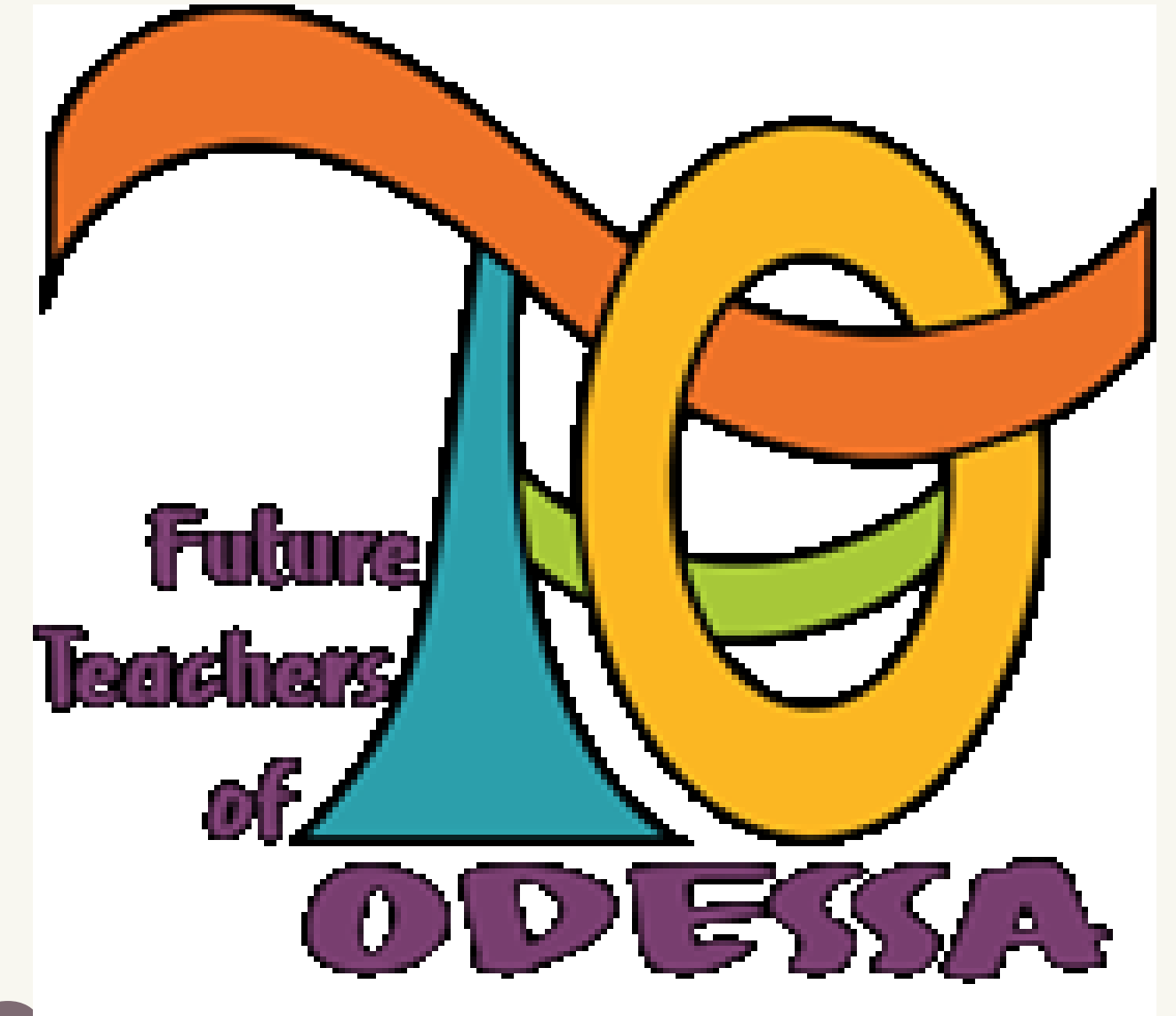

Minimum Requirements

- Must be classified as a high school student (9th-12th grade) for fall 2021
 - For current 9th, 10th, & 11th grade: must have a 2.7 GPA for ECISD & a satisfactory EOC reading score
 - For current 8th graders: must have a combined minimum average of 76 for CORE classes
 - No discipline or attendance issues
 - Must maintain at least a **78 GPA** and be professional in interactions with instructors and peers to stay in the program
 - Must maintain a college coursework GPA of 2.75

Program Details

- Monday – Friday face to face classes (16 week and 8 week courses)
 - Students will follow the ECISD Academic Calendar
 - Students will take courses at home campus while gaining exposure to the college experience
 - Students will access assignments given on Blackboard (OC LMS) & Canvas (UTPB LMS) using ECISD device
- 



Program Highlights

- All tuition and textbook fees covered by ECISD
 - Opportunity to earn up to 78 semester credit hours if starting in grade 9
 - Earn an Associate's Degree from OC
 - ECISD will issue a letter of intent to hire after successful completion of 30 semester credit hours
 - Students will sign a letter of commitment to ECISD for 2 years

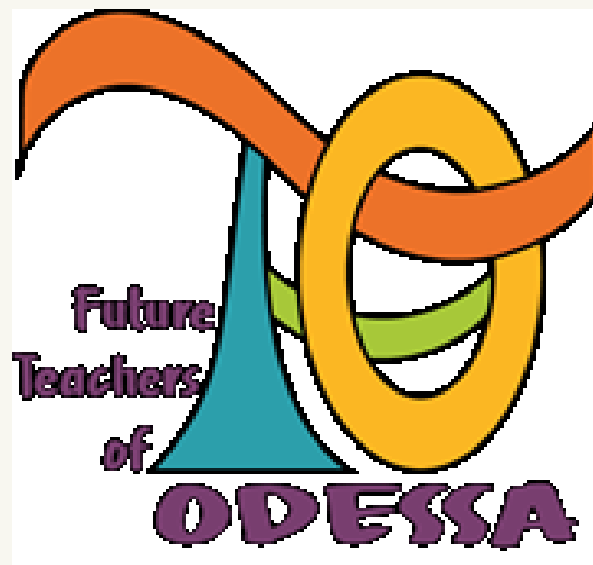

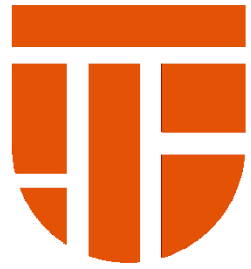
