



WHY FAMILY ENGAGEMENT?

RESEARCH SHOWS...



Students achieve more, regardless of socio-economic status, ethnic/racial background, or their parents' education level.



Involved parents create a home environment that encourages learning & those who are engaged are more likely to exhibit positive parenting practices.



Students have higher graduation rates & greater enrollment rates in post-secondary education. They develop realistic plans for their future.



Children have better self-esteem, are more self-disciplined, & show higher aspirations & motivation toward school.



Students have higher grades & test scores, better attendance, & complete homework more consistently.



Children from diverse cultural backgrounds perform better when parents & professionals collaborate.



Family participation in education is twice as predictive of student academic success as socioeconomic status.



Family engagement benefits all children, parents, teachers, schools & the community.



Students of involved parents have fewer behavioral problems. Student behaviors such as alcohol use, violence, & antisocial behavior decrease as parent involvement increases.
