Howie is from Shandong, China and will travel to his home country with his teammates in August. He said, "When I came to the United States, I never imagined I'd get to travel back home with my team. This trip is going to be an awesome experience not only for my teammates and coaches who will be travelling across the globe, but also for me and my Chinese teammates who will have the opportunity to share our culture with the people who have become like family to us in the US."

"I am excited to show my teammates the rich history and traditions of China," added sophomore Mingyi ("William") Wang, who is also a China native. "It's an awesome chance for us to learn from each other and grow together as a team on and off the court."

The Braves are set to depart for China in early August after the start of the 2024-2025 school year.
