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Greetings,

Home Education Reporting Forms for the 2024-2025 school year, along with other information, may be found on our district website at www.isd2144.org; click on Our District / Home School. Minnesota State Law requires that home educators with compulsory age students register every year with the district by October 1st. If you are no longer homeschooling, please let us know where your children are being educated.

If you are filing a Full Report (for first time home school enrollment) in fall 2024, your student must take a Nationally Normed test until age 17. If you are filing a Letter of Intent to Continue to Provide Instruction and have been homeschooling PRIOR to the fall of 2014, your student must take a Nationally Normed test until age 16.

Required Information:

- **MN Non-Public Education Compulsory Instruction Report including Norm Referenced Test information**
If you are currently enrolled with our district as a home school family you may use the Letter of Intent to Continue to Provide Instruction; families new to homeschooling or new to the district should use the Non-accredited, Nonpublic School Full Report; *or* you may use a format of your own choosing.
- **Student Immunizations (Required)** – parents are required to provide an updated copy when your child has new immunizations to report.
- **Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students (Required for reimbursement)**
To be eligible, the **students must be enrolled on or before September 15**, and must request the desired service by using Form ED-01650-34 (Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students) or in writing. **NO FORMS/REQUESTS RECEIVED AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2024 WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

The authorized rates for nonpublic pupil aids for the 2024-2025 school year are as follows:

Textbooks, Standardized Tests and Individualized Instructional Materials	\$120.97
Pupil Health Services	\$81.07
Secondary Pupil Guidance and Counseling Services	\$339.53

Rates may be adjusted on or about October 15 when the actual appropriation and program participation figures are known. You must turn your receipts in to the District Office in order to get reimbursement for items purchased during the fiscal year from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025. **Receipts must be received at the District Office no later than June 30, 2025.**
