**READING
Quarter 2**

Use comprehension skills and strategies to understand, ask questions about, and answer questions about grade level literature

- Ask and answer questions about key details
- Retell stories and demonstrate an understanding of the central message
- Describe character, settings, and major events in a story, using key details and illustrations
- Identify who is telling the story at different points in the text
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Use comprehension skills and strategies to understand, ask questions about, and answer questions about grade level informational text

- Identify the main topic and key details
- Describe the connection between two individuals, events, ideas, or pieces of information
- Know and use text features (headings, table of contents, etc...) to locate facts or information
- Use the illustrations and details in a text to describe its key ideas
- Identify the reasons an author gives to support points in a text
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Demonstrate grade appropriate phonological awareness

- Demonstrate understanding of spoken words, syllables, and sounds

Know and apply grade appropriate phonics and word analysis skills

- Know and apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding unknown words

Read grade appropriate high frequency words by sight

- Recognize and read grade level frequently occurring words with automaticity

Read on-grade-level text with understanding during small group instruction

- With prompting and support, read prose and poetry appropriate for grade 1
- With prompting and support, read informational texts appropriate for grade 1
- Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension

Use context clues and known word parts to clarify word meaning

- Use a variety of strategies to determine or clarify the meaning of a word in grade 1 text
- Demonstrate an understanding of word relationships

WRITING

Quarter 2

Fulfill the specific expectations associated with writing a particular type of text independently

- Write informative texts in which they name a topic, supply some facts about that topic, and provide a sense of closure

Print upper and lowercase letters correctly

Use conventional spelling and phonetic spelling when appropriate

- Use conventional spelling for words with common patterns.
- Spell untaught words phonetically using known letter-sound relationships

Demonstrate the use of grade-appropriate standard English grammar when writing

- Use common, proper, and possessive nouns
- Use singular and plural nouns correctly
- Use adjectives, articles, conjunctions, and prepositions

Write using correct capitalization and punctuation

SPEAKING AND LISTENING

Quarter 2

Ask and answer questions to get information or provide clarity

- Participate in collaborative conversations with partners about grade 1 topics and texts with peers and adults in small and larger groups
- Ask and answer questions about key details in a text read aloud or information presented orally
- Ask and answer questions about what a speaker says in order to gather additional information or clarify something that is not understood

Express feelings and ideas with clarity and in appropriate detail

- Describe people, places, things, and events with relevant details, expressing ideas and feelings clearly
- Add drawings to descriptions when appropriate to clarify ideas, thoughts, and feelings
- Produce complete sentences when appropriate to task and situation
- Use words and phrases acquired through conversations, reading and being read to, including using simple relationships words

Quarter 2

Operations and Algebraic Thinking

- Solve a story problem using addition and subtraction to 10 and represent answer using a number sentence
- Use the doubles plus one strategy to add three numbers
- Understand the part-part-whole relationship between addition and subtraction using number sentences
- Use a number bond to solve subtraction problems through 10
- Solve word problems using addition and subtraction to 10
- Add and subtract within 20

- Fluently add and subtract within 10
- Identify and solve for a missing addend in an addition sentence

Number and Operations Base Ten

- Count, read, write and represent numbers to 20
- Compare two 2-digit numbers using comparison vocabulary (numbers to 20)
- Add a 2-digit number to a 1-digit number, within 20

- Order three objects by length
- Measure objects using non-standard units
