Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Whitney Abel to approve the January 8, 2024 minutes as written, seconded by Connie Amaya.

Cynthia Luna with Dell Children's Health Plan introduced herself and stated that she wanted to learn more about the district and needs of the district.

Review and Discussion of Wellness Policy and Wellness Plan

Shelly Weber briefly reviewed Wellness Plan nutrition goals that were discussed last meeting and then presented Wellness Plan physical activity and other goals. Proposed plan to implement the goals was discussed. The members were given the opportunity to provide feedback.

Review of SB 629 and Narcan in the Schools

Shelly Weber notified the membership that Narcan has been available in Lockhart ISD schools since the fall of 2022. There was a new law that was passed, SB 629, and went in effect January 1st, 2024. Per this new law, all 6-12 grade schools are required to have Narcan available. Districts may decide to implement in additional grade levels and LISD has made the decision to have Narcan available at all campuses, Pre-K through 12th grade. Narcan protocol was shared with membership.

Member Comments

Elsie Lacy mentioned that there is a new Texas A&M Agrilife Extension agent that will be providing alcohol and drug education in the schools, mostly assemblies. Elsie will bring a flyer to the next meeting. Helen Tippie stated that she is a volunteer for the police department victim services and she is concerned about sex trafficking in the Austin area and wants education for teachers and students. Jaclyn Keller requested information about sex trafficking that she can put on the bulletin board outside the high school clinic. Connie Amaya commented about how much she learns at SHAC meeting and she feels inspired.
