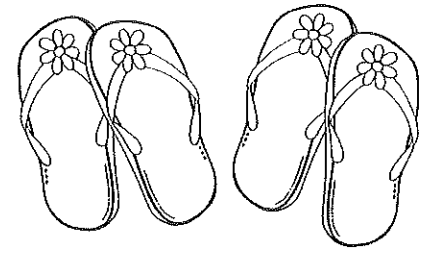

Feel- Think about things you felt at your Location.

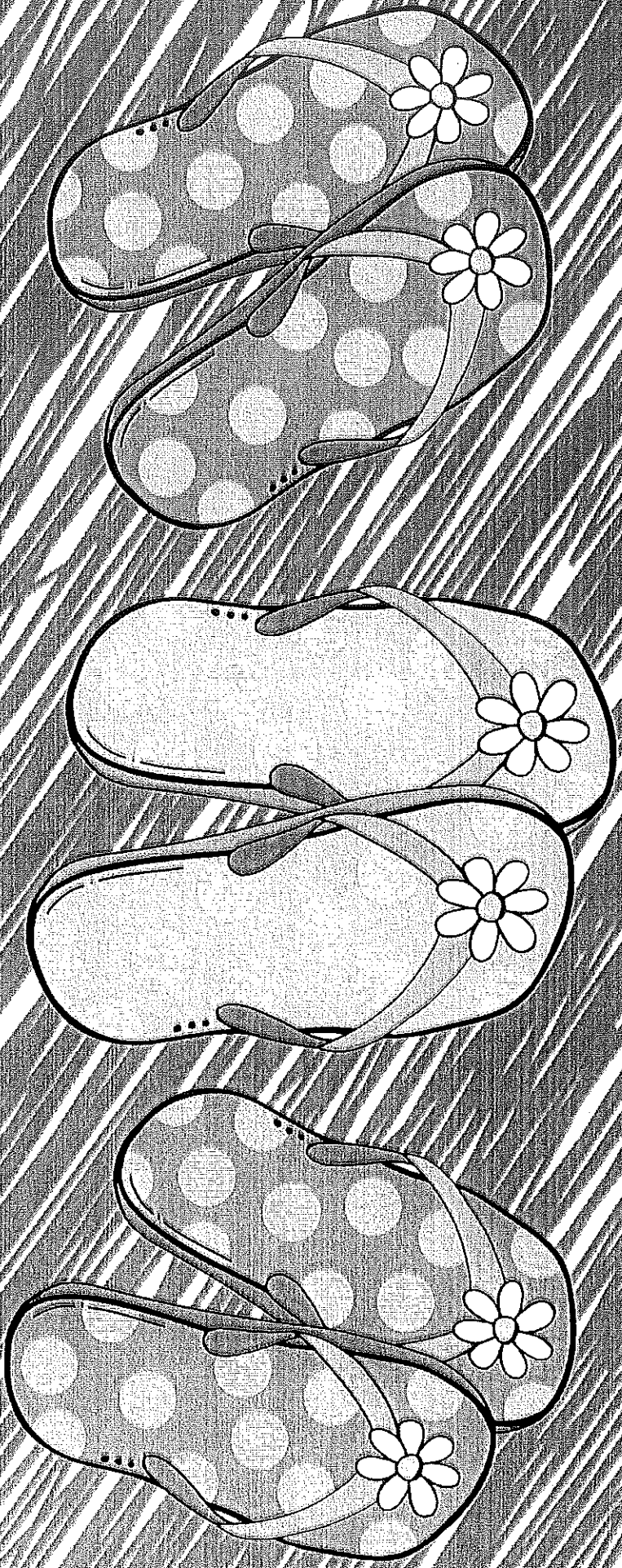

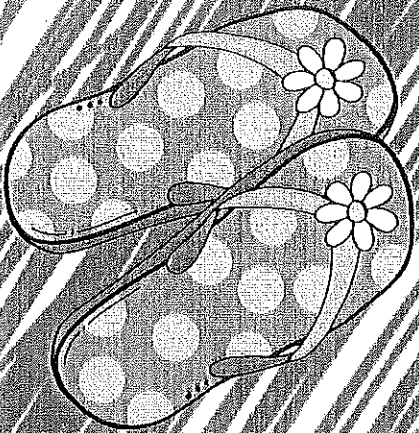

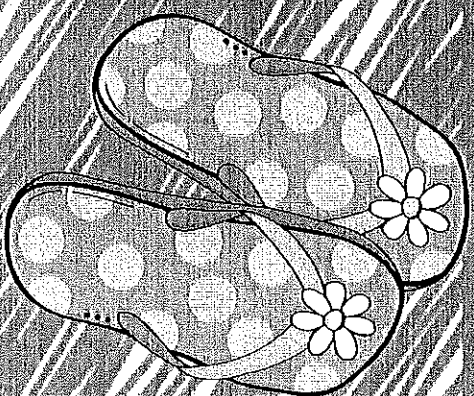

Example- Bakery (You will choose 3 to include in your writing)

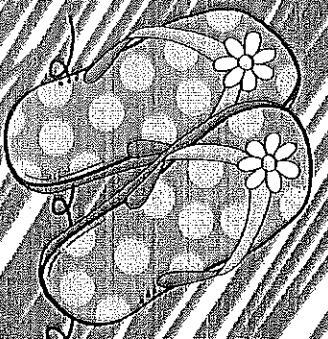
Sounds- Beeps, chatter, music, voices,

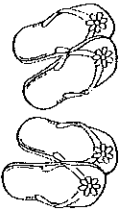
What 3 senses did I choose?
