3) Superintendent Report

Superintendent Josh Hurt

- It's May, and we are looking forward to all of our end-of-year festivities and activities.
- Congratulations to Elyda Hicks, who won the 2024 Congressional Art Competition for District 1 in Kentucky. Her artwork will be displayed in the U.S. Capitol.
- MCHS had six students chosen for the Governor's Scholars Program: 3 participants and 3 alternates
- The district celebrated Teacher Appreciation Week last week. It was also Nurse Appreciation Week.
- For agenda item 5D, we recommend the same auditor the district hired last year.
- For agenda item 5F, the district will receive approx. \$60,000 for an adjusted work order regarding the dirt work behind the high school.
- For agenda item 5J, this past school year's calendar will be adjusted for the NTI days the district used.
- For agenda item 5G, on the 2024-2025 salary schedule, we recommend a 6% raise for salary employees and an increase of \$1.25 for hourly employees. Rank III would start at \$39,000. Rank II would start at \$43,000. Rank I would start at \$50,000. "I think this is a step in the right direction, and there is more work to do. This gives us an opportunity to move forward next year, and I'm excited about it."


