Selection Process

The Winterim Director, Erin Sellers, oversees the [application process](#) in partnership with the Winterim Committee and the Trip Leaders. Applications are reviewed by the Winterim Committee, High School Admin, Counselors, and Trip Leaders, and selections will be made with the following criteria in mind.

1. Is in good standing with Fellowship Christian School
2. Have no major disciplinary infractions or suspensions
3. Demonstrate a level of maturity appropriate for international travel
4. Possess a readiness to connect with people from diverse cultures with empathy and understanding
5. Have a valid passport with an expiration date extending beyond the duration of the trip.
 - For most countries, passports must be valid for six months beyond travel dates.

Cost

The costs in the course descriptions below are our best estimations, the final price will depend on the total enrollment numbers and final travel logistics. Trip costs include airfare, accommodations, transportation, activities, and most meals, typically breakfast and dinner.

Travel Advisory Protocol

The school monitors the US Department of State travel advisories. If a country reaches or maintains a level three risk as the planned travel dates approach, the school may need to cancel the trip. Additional travel insurance may be required or offered based on geographic locations and situational events.

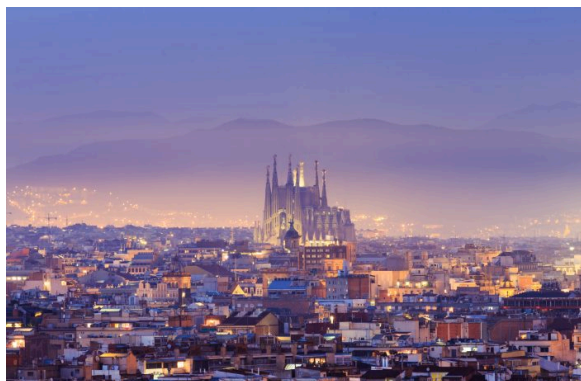
