Directions: Answer each question with a restate and proper grammar and punctuation. Each answer should be <u>3 sentences long</u> with evidence from the novel. <u>You must cite the page you are quoting.</u> For example: "Curacao was attacked by German submarines in February of 1942," (page 1).

Structure:

1st sentence – restate and answer 2nd sentence – text evidence 3rd sentence – explain or analyze how the evidence supports your answer

Directions: Answer each question with a restate and proper grammar and punctuation. Each answer should be <u>5 sentences long</u> with evidence from the novel. <u>You must cite the page you are quoting.</u> For example: "Curacao was attacked by German submarines in February of 1942," (page 1).

Structure:

1st sentence - restate and answer

2nd-5th sentences – text evidence and explain or analyze how the evidence supports your answer. Any order is acceptable, but you can only use one quote.

- 2. You have met the main character Stanley. How are YOU like him? How are YOU different from him?
