Mission and History

Mission Statement

Notre Dame de la Baie Academy, as an educational ministry of the Roman Catholic Church, educates the whole person by developing each student's Christian faith, commitment to service and full academic potential within a caring, safe, diverse Church community committed to the common good.

History of NDA

NDA was established in 1990 when St. Joseph Academy, Abbot Pennings High School and Our Lady of Premontre High School consolidated.

- St. Joseph Academy: All-girls school founded in 1896
- Abbot Pennings: All-boys school founded in 1898 as St. Norbert High School
- Our Lady of Premontre: All-boys school founded in 1941 as Central Catholic High School

Creation of the Crest

Members from the three schools created NDA's crest, which represents the rich heritage of the school. At the center of the crest is a shield and the cross of Jesus Christ. The crescent moon in the lower left of the shield represents Mary, the patroness of the school ("Notre Dame" is French for "Our Lady"). Flanking the shield on both sides is the fleur-de-lis, the French lily, which represents the school's French founding by both the Sisters of St. Joseph Carondelet (St. Joseph Academy), the Norbertines (Premontre and Abbot Pennings) and the French heritage in the Green Bay-De Pere areas. The four waves in the lower section of the crest represent the waters of Green Bay and they unite the three previous schools' alumni communities and NDA. Finally, our mascot, the Triton, symbolizes the union of the three predecessor schools.

Accreditation

NDA holds Wisconsin Religious and Independent School Accreditation (WRISA) and is a member of the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA).

Employees

Employees working at NDA are 82 employees, (77 full-time NDA Employees, 2 part-time NDA Employees and 3 CESA Employees). This includes 54 faculty members and two Norbertine priests. All faculty hold bachelor's degrees, and 26 hold advanced degrees including two with a doctorate degree. Several are currently working toward advanced degrees.

NDA uses a weighted 4.0 system to calculate grade point average (GPA). For the classes of 2023 and 2024 class rank is calculated at the end of the first semester of Junior year. Beginning with the class of 2025, Notre Dame Academy will recognize all seniors who achieve a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or above.

Honors Program

Honors classes are offered in English, Mathematics, Science and World Languages. Admission to accelerated classes, which include classes designated as “honors” or “advanced,” is determined by placement exams, teacher recommendations, past performance, and/or discussion with students and parents.

Dual-Credit Program

College credit classes are offered through St. Norbert College, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay and Northeast Wisconsin Technical College. Courses include Pre-Calculus, Calculus I, Calculus II, English, Biology and Digital Photography. All college credit classes follow the regularly planned college curriculum. International Baccalaureate and Advanced Placement courses also offer students the opportunity for additional college credits.

International Baccalaureate Programme

The IB program is an optional two-year program of rigorous learning during a student's junior and senior years. Classes are offered in six academic areas: Primary Language, Second Language, Mathematics, Science, Individuals and Society, and the Arts. Students take examinations at the end of each course. Many colleges and universities offer college credit for IB courses. Based on their scores and completion of IB requirements, students may receive an IB Diploma.

Career Explorations Program

The Career Explorations Program has four main parts. At its core, the Personal and Professional Skills course gives students real world transferable skills to facilitate success at work and in life. The second component is the Service Learning Project. Students are required to complete a minimum 50 hours of service and produce a portfolio reflecting on their experiences with evidence. The third component is the Language Portfolio. Students are required to have 50 hours of secondary language learning. Students will create a portfolio reflecting on the process and evidence of learning. Finally, students are required to write a 3,000 word reflective essay based on an ethical dilemma in the job field of their interest. Students may also be given the opportunity to earn an internship in a career field of their interest their senior year.

The Aquinas Learning Program

The Aquinas Learning Program is designed for students who enter Notre Dame Academy demonstrating need for additional support as evidenced by their middle school record and information presented on their application for admission. The program is designed to support a successful transition to high school, and develop pathways to success.

The Aquinas Learning Program works with the YMCA's Achievers program; Y-Achievers. This program boosts academic achievement and career success, creating confident youth and stronger communities. Each student enrolled in the Y-Achievers program attends weekly to biweekly meetings. Meetings will be centered around a curriculum that focuses on life skills, career development, college preparation and developing a positive sense of self. Students will have the opportunity to attend field trips offered once a month.
