How and when is the Culminating Project graded? (P. 12 of the Handbook)

 Students are graded as they are presenting. Each panel member has an evaluation sheet and agree on a overall score for the student.

Overall Rating:

- ☐ Level 4: Exceeds Standard (Advanced, 24 22 points)
- ☐ Level 3: Meets Standard (Proficient, 21 18 points)
- ☐ Level 2: Approaching Standard (Basic, 17 12 points)
- ☐ Level 1: Does Not Meet Standard (Below Basic, 11 6 points)

☐ Level 1*: Does Not Meet Standard

(Student has a score of "1" in one or more of the required Content areas & even though a total score of 18 or higher may have been earned, the presentation does not meet standard.)

What happens if a student does not meet standard on the Culminating Project?

• Students who do not meet standard on their initial Culminating Project Senior Presentation will be provided feedback and they will revise their presentation. Students will then have an opportunity to present their Culminating Project a second time to another panel of adults.

Will students who do not meet standard on the Culminating Project be able to graduate?

• The current policy with Walla Walla Public Schools places the culminating project as a **mandatory non-credit graduation requirement**. Thus, students will not receive a diploma without completing the Culminating Project Senior Presentation.

¿Cómo y cuándo se califica el Proyecto Culminante?

• Los miembros del panel califican al estudiante mientras presenta. Luego, se ponen de acuerdo para el puntaje final para el estudiante.

Calificación general:
□ Nivel 4: Avanzado o Supera el estándar (22 - 24 puntos)
□ Nivel 3: Competente o Cumple con el estándar (18 - 21 puntos)
□ Nivel 2: Básico o Se acerca al estándar, pero aún no cumple el estándar (12 - 17 puntos)
□ Nivel 1: Inferior al básico o No cumple con el estándar (6 - 11 puntos)
□ Nivel 1*: No cumple con el estándar (El estudiante tiene una puntuación de "1" en una o más de las áreas de contenido aunque se haya obtenido una puntuación total de 18 o más, la presentación no cumple con el estándar).

¿Qué sucede si un estudiante no cumple con el estándar en el Proyecto Culminating?

• Los estudiantes que no cumplan con el estándar en su presentación inicial del Proyecto Culminating Senior recibirán comentarios y revisarán su Proyecto Culminating. Luego, los estudiantes tendrán la oportunidad de presentar su Proyecto Culminante por segunda vez a otro panel de adultos.

¿Podrán graduarse los estudiantes que no cumplan con el estándar del Proyecto Culminante?


La política actual con las Escuelas Públicas de Walla Walla coloca el proyecto culminante como un requisito obligatorio de
