


Q1: Did the perceived quality of the SAU70 schools have an impact on your decision to live specifically in Hanover or Norwich?














Q15: Does your child have difficulty obtaining nutritious meals?




















Q39: Does providing caregiving or activities for your child during school breaks present challenges for your family?


















Q61: Do you have multiple children in the schools?






Q64: What is the highest educational attainment of a member of your immediate household?




Q66: What is the race of your child?


Q67: What is the ethnicity of your child?
