
SAU70 2022 Strategic Planning Survey June 2022: RMS Only

Strategic Planning Survey: 503 responses: 81 specific to RMS

- June 2022 survey sent out to parents, staff, and the community
- Open for multiple weeks until July 1st with multiple reminders from Superintendent
- 47-Item survey
- Participants invited to put in their personal information and be contacted by the Superintendent and his staff; these follow-up meetings (n=40) occurred in summer and fall 2022
- Items included 12 free-text response questions; see next slide for summary
- Redacted (to eliminate potentially identifiable information) free-text responses will be available separately; 90-page PDF; RMS 19-page PDF
 - Free-text responses similar to "no", "NA", etc. were removed




Q6: Please assess this aspect of our schools. Please click on one of the three options.Intensity of extracurricular activities, such as athletics and theater




Q7: Please assess this aspect of our schools. Please click on one of the three options.Intensity and pressure to succeed



















Amount of Covid-related communication from the schools and staff










