
Strategic Planning Survey: 503 responses: 154 specific to HHS

- June 2022 survey sent out to parents, staff, and the community
- Open for multiple weeks until July 1st with multiple reminders from Superintendent
- 47-Item survey
- Participants invited to put in their personal information and be contacted by the Superintendent and his staff; these follow-up meetings (n=40) occurred in summer and fall 2022
- Items included 12 free-text response questions; see next slide for summary
- Redacted (to eliminate potentially identifiable information) free-text responses will be available separately; 90-page PDF; HHS 36-page PDF
 - Free-text responses similar to "no", "NA", etc. were removed
































