#### LEARNING SNAPSHOT

**Year 1** have had a busy week! In their 'Chop, Slice and Mash' Topic, the children have been taste testing a variety of vegetables and salad dressings and enjoyed designing and making their own salads. On Thursday, the children enjoyed a visit to the Natural History Museum to learn about animals as part of their Science topic. They enjoyed grouping animals into mammals, reptiles, invertebrates, amphibians, fish and birds.

Ask me: What was in my salad?



**Year 2** In DT, our topic is 'Push and Pull'. We have been learning about different mechanisms that can be used to create movement and this week we focussed on the level mechanism. In maths we have been learning about pictograms and answering different questions about data. We have also started learning about Queen Victoria as part of our 'Magnificent Monarchs' topic.

Ask me: Can you name a famous Monarch?



**Year 3** had an amazing second week of term of designing and creating! As young, keen artists we designed and created our own mosaics, having been inspired by the ancient Roman mosaics around the world. We also started our new Art unit – Botanical Artists, using natural materials to make our botanical weavings. In Design and Technology, we researched different Greenhouses; asking questions to determine similarities and differences of other greenhouses in the UK. In Maths, we have started our new unit on 'Shapes', using our understanding of fractions to describe turns and find different angles.

Ask me: How has the design and structure of the greenhouse changed over time?







Year 4 This week the children enjoyed their baseball lesson, developing their pitching skills. The mini baseball games at the end of each lesson are rapidly becoming a Year 4 favourite as they learn the rules and skills of the game. In the classroom we have completed most of the Year 4 assessments. Having spent the week practising timetables the children completed their timetables test on Wednesday. We will provide the results when they are made available. Finally, the children have begun to plan their stalls for the Year 4 fair at the end of term.

Ask me: Can you demonstrate how to pitch the ball in baseball?



**Reception** have been consolidating their maths learning from earlier in the year this week and we started by making various patterns of numbers. WE began by making patterns of 4 and later in the week made patterns of 6. The children were challenged to work as a team to make different patterns using cubes before having a try independently and drawing the patterns. As part of our preparation for Year 1, we have also been practicing number formation and recognition and we even had a maths lesson in the Year 1 classroom!

Ask me: to show you some different patterns of 4 and 6.
