You should take notes as you listen, so bullet points are acceptable. This is not something that you can save for the last minute, so you should be working on it throughout the summer.

What bills are Congress working on/debating?

What message is President Biden trying to send to the American people?

How is the economy doing, and what is the government doing to help it?

What is going on in other countries (Ukraine, Palestine, China) and how are American leaders responding?

What major decisions have our federal courts been making?

Who are some rising stars in the Democratic and Republican parties?

What is going on with the Trump trials?

What are Democrats and Republicans fighting about?

What should we expect to happen in the 2024 elections?

Have there been any protests?

What should we expect from the national party conventions?
