Scheduling a Visit to UPrep

We are delighted that UPrep will be included in your fall travel plans!

Scheduling: To schedule a visit, please visit Scoir. Your visit request is pending until confirmed in Scoir. Visit requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis due to space availability. UPrep employs a hybrid approach to visits, offering both in-person and virtual visit options. To see our complete schedule of visit options, please log into <u>Scoir</u>.

Parking: There is limited parking in front of UPrep on NE 80th Street. There is plenty of parking along 25th Avenue, at Dahl Playfield, and in the surrounding residential neighborhoods.

Arrival: After parking your car, please enter UPrep through the main entrance, which located on 80th Street approximately one-half block east of 25th Avenue NE. All visitors are required to check-in at the Main Office to receive a visitor pass. Upon receiving your visitor badge, please walk to the ULab, which is located across the street from the Main Campus at 2416 NE 80th Street. The College Counseling Office is located on the first floor of the ULab building.

Visits: Visits are held in the College Counseling Office in the ULab. The start time that we advertise to students is the time listed in Scoir. Please allow 10 to 15 minutes in your travel schedule for check-in and a short walk to the ULab. Each visit is scheduled for 30 minutes. We have found that the most productive high school visit incorporates a presentation style where discourse, humor, and questions allow for students and college representatives to learn a great deal from one another.
