Student Wellness and Success and DPIA Funding Plan FY 2024

Initiative one: Mental Wellness and Health Support

Identification of Need:

Revere Local School District is dedicated to ensuring a supportive school culture for our students. We have witnessed an increase in the need for providing student wellness support over the last several years. Our school-based counselors provide tier one and tier two support for our students' mental health and well-being. As part of the counseling teams throughout the district, our at-risk coordinator also supports students well-being, along with supporting school attendance and serving as a homeless liaison.

Students receive small group and individual support with our at-risk coordinator, in conjunction with our local Educational Service Center. This service provides counseling and mental health support, along with homeless and attendance support for at-risk students.

Community Partner:

Educational Service Center of Northeast Ohio

Allocation: \$2,072.22

Initiative Two: Physical Wellness and Health Support

Nursing support: RN and nursing support in each building: 75, 000

Provides existing district-wide RN and nursing services at each of the four school buildings on a daily basis

Community Partners:

1. PSI is a partner of the Ohio Department of Education and many other organizations across the state. PSI supports the mental physical needs of our students. Ensuring students' physical health needs are being met helps to ensure students well-being and academic lives are being supported as well.

2. Education Service Center of Northeast Ohio partners with us to help provide mental wellness and at-risk student support
