2024-2025 School Calendar



The 2024-2025 School Calendar was approved by the School Board at their March 7th meeting. Also approved at the meeting was the number of traditional "snow days" for the 2024-2025 school year. Next year's calendar will allow for up to two " traditional snow days" (or any type of no school days). If more

than the allotted two days are needed, those days will be asynchronous remote learning days. Therefore, the latest possible in-person school day for 2024-2025 (if 2 days are used) will be June 13, 2025.

2024 School Building Advisory Committee

NEW CITIZEN-LED SCHOOL BUILDING ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO ASSIST IN DEVELOPING SCHOOL SOLUTION

SBAC PRESENTS FOUR SCHOOL CONCEPTS

In Phase 1, the School Building Advisory Committee (SBAC) developed exploratory concepts for four new school solutions:

• Build a 4th primary school

- Renovate existing K-2s & add Pre-K
- New Grade 2-3 school (consolidated)
 - Existing primary schools become K-1
- Preserve the primaries and Middle School
 - Build new additions at existing schools
- New K-3 community school (consolidated)
 - New build; repurpose existing school buildings



Current costs for these plans are ballpark figures based on best estimates. Costs are not yet validated as of June 2024. <u>View the full presentations here</u>. A detailed report is forthcoming.

The SBAC plans to recommend sending all four concepts to Phase 2 of the process, where they will be thoroughly vetted by professional design and engineering teams. During Phase 2, costs will be validated and land options will be explored. It is expected that the plans will continue to evolve. This work will begin in Fall 2024.

The Board of Education will vote on whether to accept the SBAC's recommendation in its June 27th meeting. The SBAC will present its recommendation, followed by discussion, during the school board workshop, starting at 5:30. The workshop will be open to public comment. The vote will take place during the meeting, which starts at 7 pm. The public is invited to attend the workshop and meeting in person at Town Hall or <u>on Zoom.</u> (The Town Council will vote on the recommendation the day before, at its June 26 meeting; however the full SBAC presentation will be given only during the June 27 workshop.)
