Personalized Learning (PerL) with 1:1 Devices

All students at Plymouth Middle School are provided with Chromebooks to personalize and support learning inside and outside of the classroom. Information will be communicated in our August back to school letter.

Device Protection Plans

- The Device Protection Plan (DPP) fee is \$25 per student. Payment instructions below.
- DPP covers accidental damage to your Chromebook.
- DPP does not cover loss or intentional damage.
- Stolen devices require a police report.
- DPP does not cover the Chromebook charger or the case.

Important Reminders

- The first accidental damage is fully covered for the Chromebook.
- For subsequent accidental damages, a \$25 fine is applied.
- Students will be required to use a backpack with a laptop pocket for transporting the device to and from school.
- Students will receive a district-supplied case.
