QUICK TIPS!

FIRST GRADE 2024-2025

To ensure your child is confident and well prepared for entering first grade, he/she would benefit from engaging in the following activities during the summer months:

Daily Reading

Help your child decorate a library bag. Visit your public library to fill it with books. Join the library's summer reading program. Get your child his/her own library card! Don't forget to have your child practice retelling the information/stories from the books he/she reads in sequence with lots of details.

Daily Writing

Let your child pick out a writing journal to decorate. Use the journal as a scrapbook in which he/she may draw pictures or paste photos, tickets, post cards, etc. from events and activities he/she participates in. After drawing a picture or pasting an item onto a page, have your child write a caption describing the special event. Voila, a memory book in the making!

Daily Counting Activities

Help your child practice counting by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s to 120. Make it fun... a great game for the car. Help your child get familiar with coins, and time to the hour. Practice simple addition facts and writing 2-digit numbers.
