**4. Describe the action steps the school/district will take to reduce the opportunity gap in student possession of ASB cards and/or participation in extracurricular activities for the upcoming school year.**

We will continue with the action steps from previous two years. Due to the improved communication and program adjustments, South Whidbey has made some dramatic improvement with our Low Income families' participation in extracurricular activities. We are literally two (2) students away from passing the Gap threshold. Our expectations are to continue to improve.

We have increased in one year from 20% to 40% participation in extracurricular (SWA). We went from 23 students to 58 students from low income household participating in extracurricular (SWHS).

NEW FOR 2024-25

- Update website to inform families that waivers for sports fees are available, with explanations on who, why, and how.
- Communicate to Readiness to Learn information regarding the waivers available and paperwork. RTL works directly with families in our District that are financially struggling.
- Intramural sports starting in the fall and changing what sports are offered based on which sports seasons are coming up. This is to help introduce the participation options for students who may not have had the financial capacity to participate in activities/sports at the Parks and Rec level.
- Host a Sports Fair during lunch during the first week of school, with flyers and registration information, including information that would support low income families, such as fee waivers and how to get affordable Sports Physicals.
