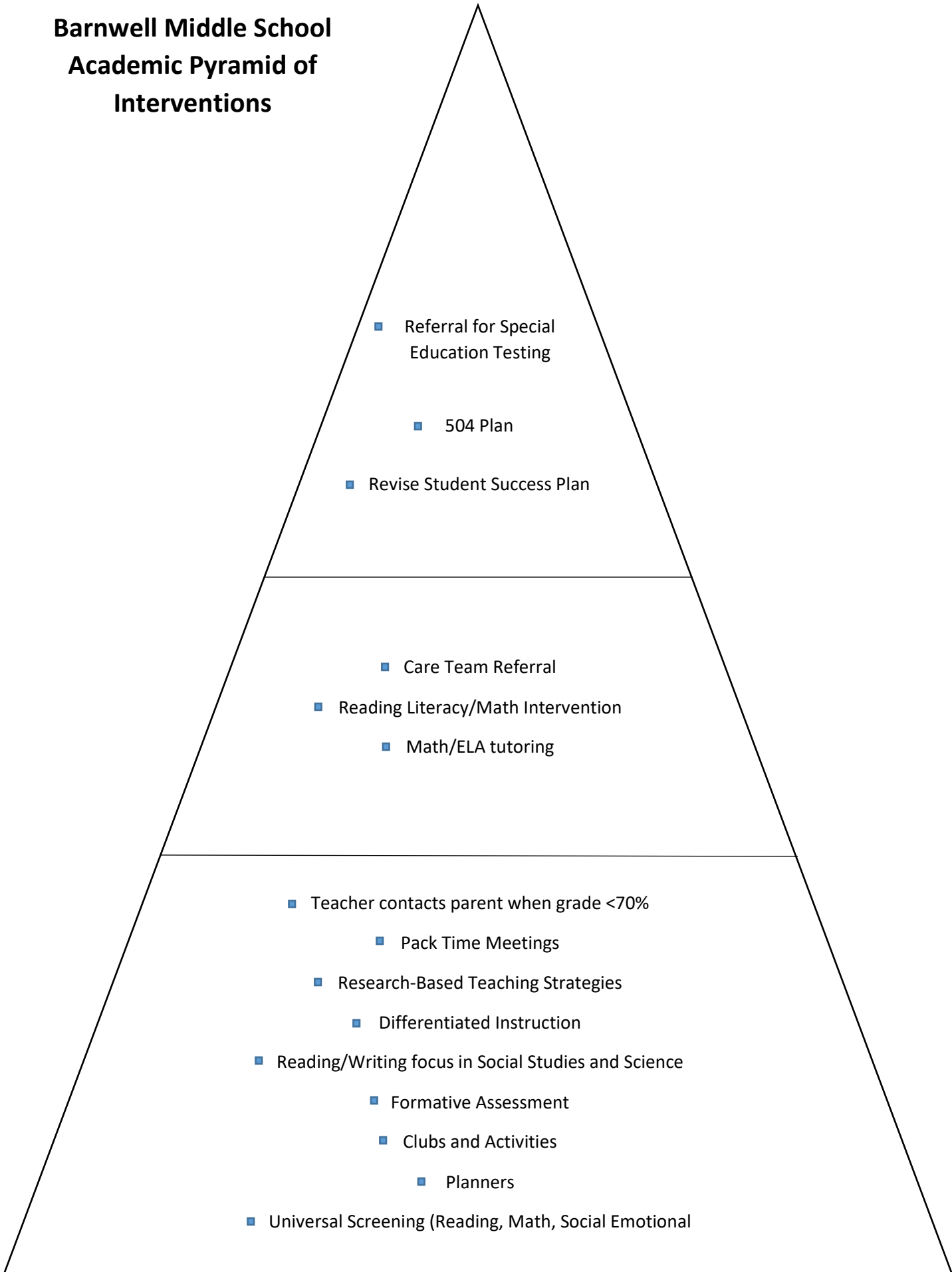


Barnwell Middle School Academic Pyramid of Interventions



Middle School Attendance Tiers

First 10 Days: Monitor attendance to identify at-risk students, meet with students to explain attendance processes, and contact home to address concerns until improvements are made

Foundational Supports

- Character Strong within Ac.Lab time
- Relationship & Community Building
- Trauma-Informed Approach to Students
- Provide Engaging Curriculum
- School Counseling Curriculum

Tier 1: 90%-100%

- Attendance Informational Letters Quarterly
- Attendance Visuals such as posters and bulletin boards
- Positive Recognition of students making or improving their attendance

Tier 2: 85%-89%

- **Parent Phone Call** regarding Attendance Concerns
- In-Person Check with grade level counselor (discuss the connection to school and possible activities to join)
- **Student Success Plan** - Completed by student with grade level counselor and shared with parent via email
- Refer to the CARE team as needed
- Utilize Drop In to catch up on academic work as needed
- Check-In/Check-Out Champion

Tier 3: 81%-84%

- Administrator/Student Conference & Check-In with Family
- Consider Schedule Changes or Modified Schedule
- Weekly Counselor Check-in for Goal Setting

Tier 4: Below 80%

- Diversionary Conference with Family
- Diversionary Referral
- Consider Modified Schedule, Homebound, Virtual, System of Care
- Hotline to be made after 10 unexcused absences
