Overview:

The students will travel to Eastern Kentucky to serve families in need in Appalachia. Students will serve the local community by assisting in home repair projects (both large and small).

- To serve the needy, sick, widowed, and elderly
- To experience different and difficult ways of life in the U.S.

Course Goals:

- *To build community within our students*
- To grow as Christians
- Hike at the Red River Gorge on the return trip home

Description:

Big Creek Missions serves its local community through construction services, as well as food and clothing services. The Big Creek Mission campus has bunkrooms, a cafeteria, a chapel, gym, and outdoor recreation areas. Students will be divided into small work teams and drive to their respective work locations. Teams will work on home repairs of all types, ranging from roof repair to constructing wheelchair ramps. The mission also serves the community through partnerships with local food pantries, clothing centers, churches, and nursing homes.

The group will hike at the Red River Gorge on Friday and enjoy a celebratory lunch together on the return trip home. This trip will leave **early** morning on Tuesday, October 22 and return early evening on Friday, October 25.

A typical day with the mission:

6:45 am - Wake Up

7:00 am – Students will have a hot breakfast in the cafeteria. Team members build their own lunch at the lunch stations and pack it in their team cooler that will go with them to their work sites.

8:00 am - Morning Worship & Sendoff.

8:20 am - Adult meeting / Student team meetings to go over the day's plans

8:50 am – Drivers and their teams will load the vehicles and head out to the work site for the day. Lunch break by teams.

4:30 pm - Return to Big Creek campus ... shower, nap, relax, go outside and play, whatever we want to do.

5:30 pm – Dinner, a full cafeteria style dinner and salad bar every evening, except Wednesday (night out)

7:30 pm - Worship! We'll gather again for worship in the evening to end our day right!

8:30 pm - Church Group meeting times when our teams can gather and share their experience that day. 10:45 pm – lights out.

Students who want to serve others and who don't mind getting dirty and This course is well suited to:

learning how to use tools to fix or build things for people in need.
