Overview: A family-owned nonprofit, Clutter 2 Care was established in 2018 by a CHCA alumni family. It is a thrift store focused on raising funds for at-risk and marginalized children in our community and all over the world.

- Course Goals:**
- Serve low-income families and community through hands on work at Clutter2Care thrift store
 - Learn and grow in your faith through daily devotions and reflections with course leader and the owner of Clutter2Care.

Description:

Students will be working with store customers, aiding families in making choices and will be spending time sorting items in the Clutter2Care warehouse. Daily devotional will be held at Clutter2Care each morning to prepare for the day.

Daily schedule:

Arrive CHCA Founders' Campus by 8:00 a.m.

Depart CHCA for Clutter2Care at 8:30 a.m.

Morning devotions and explanation of work

Serve- helping with displays, pack/price/sort, customer care, other tasks as needed at the store.

Lunch – students should pack a bag lunch on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Lunch will be provided on Friday.

Depart C2C for school between 1:30- 2:15 each day.

This experience may involve a field trip to one of Clutter2Care's partner organizations.

This course is well suited to: Students who like hard work, learning about running a non-profit and enjoy helping others.

Additional costs: Students need a packed lunch 3 days

Other Information:

Students should be dressed neatly but in clothes intended for helping to work sorting items. School dress code applies.
