Dear Parent:

Thank you for your interest in Metairie Park Country Day School. Our Admission Committee assesses our applicants in a variety of ways. For example, we interview each applicant on his/her visit day; and we review school transcripts, recommendations, and student writing samples. We also require that your child take a standardized test as part of the admission process.

Country Day cooperates with other ISAS schools in setting admission policies. Since we exchange test information, it is not necessary to have your child tested at more than one ISAS school. ERB scores, which some independent school students take during the school year, can also be used to complete your child's standardized test requirement. Students graduating from a local independent school may be exempt as well.

Here is information regarding test registration:

- Registration for the ISEE must be done online from the [ERB website](#) at least 2 weeks in advance (but preferably 3 weeks in advance).
- Select **“Create Account,”** and provide the requested parent information.
- Select **“Add Student,”** and provide the requested student information.
- Select **“Search and Register”** for Available Tests. You can find available testing using the date, school code (191782), or event code.
- Country Day will offer the ISEE on the following dates:

Saturday, December 7, 2024
Event Code: EYTTR5RU
Register by November 16
Late Registration available until November 23

Saturday, January 25, 2025
Event Code: PY7QWQPN
Register by January 4
Late Registration available until January 11

- **For Score Recipient, please enter “Metairie Park Country Day” or our code 191782. This is an important step! Please do not skip it.**
- The fee for registration is \$155. Late registration is \$185. Walk-in registration is \$195.
- Using your account credentials, you will be able to manage various aspects of your test registration, including printing your registration ticket (bring it with you on your test date), viewing your scores, and adding score recipients. If you are unable to register on-line or to pay by credit card, please let me know so we can assist you in your child's registration process.

Study guides are available for purchase on the ISEE website but are not necessary. We do recommend that your child becomes familiar with the test using the information on the ISEE website.

If your child requires **special accommodations** for testing, you will be given the option to select that upon creating an account. Carefully review the requirements for approval and all available options. Accommodations must be approved by ERB prior to registering for a test, and requests must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the test date.

On the day of testing, please arrive in our main building at the designated “Check In” time (8:30 AM). Each student should bring a few sharpened #2 pencils, his/her registration ticket, and a snack. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out.
