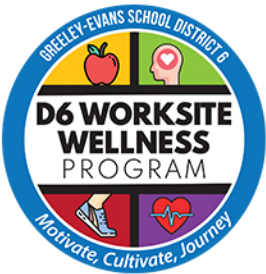


20-21 INTEREST SURVEY RESULTS
