Registration Fee

The Registration Fee is payable to enrol your child for the school and is non-refundable. It does not guarantee your child a place at the school.

- UK and EU residents: £100
- Non-EU residents: £400

Deposit

Receipt of the deposit by the school guarantees your child's place.

UK and EU residents

- Tick Tock & Kindergarten: £200
- Reception to Year 8: £400

Non-EU residents:

- One Term's full boarding fees: £11,500

Once the deposit is received, the school will be able to act as sponsor for any visa application required. The term deposit is refundable once all amounts owing have been cleared.

Explanation of Fees

The Day Fee

The basic day fee covers tuition, all teaching facilities, textbooks, exercise books, meals and snacks, sport, match travel and most activities. Individual or group tuition for learning a musical instrument, speech and drama, sports coaching or for learning support is charged as an Extra.

The Full Boarding Fee

This covers everything included in the Basic Day Fee plus all general boarding costs. It includes up to £50 worth of weekend activities per term. Anything which your child participates in over £50 per term will be added to your bill. For most boarders, the £50 included per term is sufficient to cover all such activities. Pocket money is to be handed to the house parents for safekeeping and distribution as required.

Weekly Boarding Fee

This covers everything included in the Basic Day Fee plus all general boarding costs for five nights a week. If staying for more than five nights per week, please contact the school at office@moorpark.org.uk. Any trips at the weekends will be charged as an extra. Each term, children will have up to £25 of activities during the week-day period included in their stay. Anything beyond this will be charged as an extra.

Flexi-Boarding

Flexi-boarding is available to Day Pupils from Year 3 and up at £45 per night. Advance flexi-boarding packages are available at £40 per night if booked in advance, before the start of term. After the start of term, flexi-boarding nights can only be booked at £45 per night. This fee covers boarding activities, including supper and breakfast, supervision, care and medical care overnight. Accompanying full-time boarders on trips will be charged in full as an extra. Flexi-Boarders who stay on Sundays for activities will be charged for additional meals, trips and activities as normal.

Changing Flexi-Boarding arrangements and Missed Nights

- Illness or other exceptional circumstance: we will do our best to enable missed nights to be re-booked without charge subject to availability.
- Change of regular boarding night(s): please forward your request to office@moorpark.org.uk and the school will do its best to accommodate your request, subject to availability.
- One-off changes to boarding nights: we will try to facilitate these wherever possible, the exception being a swap to any special/themed nights and weekends.
- Boarding nights booked in advance are not transferrable between siblings.

Reception Fees

Reception children receive several specialist-taught activities which are included in the Day Fee. These include Mini Movers Dance classes, Sports Stars activity, music lessons and Woodland School.

Other extra-curricular lessons are available on request and incur an additional charge e.g. tennis coaching, ballet, individual music lessons.

Until the term in which your child turns 5 years old, they will be entitled to the 15 government funded hours per week. Eligible working families will be able to claim 30 hours of funded care per week. Whilst eligible, the value of these hours will be deducted from your termly fee.

Kindergarten Fees

Children generally move into this class in the term after they turn three and remain until the July before they transfer into Reception. However, children may transfer in the term before they turn three if all the transfer requirements have been met.

The kindergarten day is divided into two sessions, each of equal length and value:

- Morning: 08.00am to 11.45am (funded hours 8.15am to 11.15am)
- Afternoon: 12.15pm to 3.45pm (funded hours 12.45pm to 3.45pm)

Tick Tock Fees

The fees include breakfast, lunch, snack and tea. We provide milk or water to drink. Several high-quality, specialist taught extra-curricular activities are available to all children depending on which day your child is booked in, and the age of your child. These include 'Sing and Sign' Baby signing sessions, Mini Movers Dance classes, Mini Music Makers, Sports Stars and Woodland School.

Standard Charges and Payment Options

Personal Accident Insurance:

£14.15 per term

It is essential that all children have personal accident cover and, therefore, given the small premium, it is school policy that this insurance is obligatory.

School Fees Refund Scheme:

- a) 1% of basic boarding fee for boarders**
- b) 1.3% of basic day fee for day pupils**

This policy offers reimbursement of fees for periods of absence or missed classes due to illness. The scheme also includes accidental death cover. This scheme operates on an opt-in basis. Please notify the Finance Officer if you wish to join the scheme.

Doctor's Fee:

£17.50 per term

All full and weekly boarders are registered with a local GP Practice which provides a consultation either at school or the local surgery, as well as normal medical cover. For this service, we charge a small fee per full boarding pupil and this is added to the account.

Bursary and Facilities Fund

This is an opt-in facility. Should you wish to opt in, a contribution of £50 is added to your bill to help finance bursary awards and capital projects. If you wish to opt in or make a higher contribution, then please notify the Finance Officer. Gift Aid forms are also available for these contributions. This will enable the school to claim an additional 25% on your donation to this fund.

Billing periods

Bills for **Kindergarten to Year 8** are issued three times per year as follows:

- July for the Michaelmas Term plus any Summer Term extras
- December for the Lent Term and any Michaelmas Term extras
- March for the Summer Term and any Lent Term extras

The due date for payment is the first day of term.

Bills for **Tick Tock** are produced and due monthly and must be paid by the 1st of each month. If not received in time a late charge of £20 is applied to each month's bill.

- b) By monthly standing order. For parents who would like the facility to pay monthly, we can accept a monthly standing order arrangement provided that the term's fees are covered by four instalments and payments commence in the month prior to the start of term. Details are available from the Bursar.

Bursaries and Discounts

Fees in Advance Discount

Parents may be able to take advantage of discounted fees if they pay for fees in advance. If parents wish to take advantage of this scheme, they should contact the Bursar at bursar@moorpark.org.uk.

Bursaries

Bursaries may be made available to existing parents who are experiencing unexpected financial hardship or, in exceptional cases, to new parents who are not able to pay full fees. Bursaries are generally only available to families with children in Year 3 and above. Details of the school's policy on bursaries are available from the Bursar.

Please be aware that all bursary offers must remain confidential between the parents and the school.

HM Armed Forces Discount

The school has a policy of offering allowances to children of members of the regular armed forces. Members of HM Armed Forces who do not qualify for the Continuing Education Allowance (CEA) qualify for a 20% discount on the basic day fee for each child.

Regular personnel in HM Forces who are able to claim the CEA allowance will receive a discount to ensure the parent contribution toward Boarding Fees is 10% of the full boarding fee.

Sibling discount

Parents with 3 children at the school will receive a 10% discount on their third child's basic day fee. A fourth child at the school will receive a 25% discount on the basic day fee. Please note that these discounts only apply while 3 or 4 children from the same family attend Moor Park at the same time.

Extra Tuition and other Extras

Extras such as outings and learning support/language tuition are charged in arrears. Speech and drama and musical instrument tuition are charged in advance.

The following fees apply:

Where a parent has an outstanding account, the child will not be permitted to continue with a chargeable extra.

Half a term's notice is required to cease any extra tuition lessons and any other chargeable activities.

Years 1 and 2

3.45pm-6pm, Monday to Friday, including tea and specialised activity: £18.30 per evening. All bookings are placed and paid for termly in advance. There is no refund of fees due to non-attendance/illness/holidays.

Year 3

Year 3 After School Club from 4:00-6:00pm and tea is included in the day fee.
