# <u>MEDICATIONS</u>: PICK-UP YOUR CHILD'S MEDICATION BY THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL. Any medications that are not picked-up will be discarded the following day.

You will need to obtain a medication form over the summer for any medications your child will need for the 2023-2024 School Year. <u>ALL</u> medications require a district permission form that is signed by a parent and a physician's order. Including prescriptions OR anything Over-The-Counter (OTC) with a labeled "active ingredient", e.g. vitamins, cough drops, homeopathies, ibuprofen, etc. Exceptions, written into education code; hand sanitizers and sunscreen. Lotions/oils that don't have labeled "active ingredient" may permitted – when in doubt, call the health office!!
