### MINUTES

October 27, 2015

- I. Meeting called to order at 4:06 pm
- II. Discussion of Feedback from School Sites--  
Guiding principles: Safety/Security, Collaboration, Technology Enriched Environments, Outdoor Learning, Sustainability, Community
  - Blue Oak—Staff felt that part of the issue is the campus is crowded and so many ideas address these concerns. Needs: Upgrade staff bathrooms, enlarge workroom, more staff parking, realign drop off area, remodel portables, staff bathroom at far end of campus  
Wants: amphitheater, larger windows, improve health office, backpack hooks
  - Brooks—Staff agreed with the priority of the guiding principles. Wants: collaborative classrooms, connection to outdoors, parking lot improvements, improve/enlarge administration building including secretarial area, health office and conference space
  - Buckeye—K teachers want the poster drawers replaced, shade structures for all the drop off/pick up areas. Shade structure for playground area. Adjoining classrooms possible?
  - Oak Meadow—ranked the guiding principles. Wants: connection to outdoors, greater open spaces, more adaptable furniture, landscaping, dance studio, green screen, water fountain, shade structure over the play structure, less individual desks to aid collaboration, replace curtains, parking concerns/flow. Some other area for kids to eat indoors—only one multi-purpose room now that has to be shared for PE and indoor lunch. Remove center island in pods for more flexible use space? Would be great to be able to house 12 kids.
  - Silva Valley—Parking/flow issues—make current bus drop on convert to parent drop off; collaboration-rolling furniture (remove permanent furniture for more flexibility), mobile boards; solar; computer lab to science lab or an adaptable room; outdoor learning areas, increase number of shade structures; better layout of classrooms
  - Camerado Springs—outdoor space wants—amphitheater, utilize the nature area, improve hard courts, improve accessibility to field. Library flexibility—less stacks for more collaborative areas, classrooms to have more collaborative areas and furniture—moveable Promethean boards?
  - Rolling Hills—improve locker rooms—too small, improve M building- no common workspace areas or at least connecting doors. Can you build behind the M building? Staff bathrooms in multiple spaces. Utilize the open areas in F building for additional staff bathrooms? Additional multipurpose room—no place for kids to eat indoors on rainy days. Improve kitchen-not large enough for size of school. Shade structure for amphitheater. Back pack hooks outside science building. Flexible spacing for library. More stairs to get from front of school to parking lot—currently only at the ends. Conference space.

- Valley View—District office facilities are currently housed here—what is the need and long term plan for the district office? Needs: office spaces, training spaces, board room space—7,000 to 8,000 SF. Also need for on-site storage. Discussed possible locations for new district office. To be most accessible, the Silver Dove School Site could work but far down the road. Silver Dove would require the Bass Lake Specific Plan to be completed to allow for the needed improvements necessary to build the district office.
- Transportation Area—Other needs are greater, adequate at this time.
- Central Kitchen—Discussed possibility of the need for an additional central kitchen in the future. Perhaps at the Bass Lake Site in the future.
